Often referred to as Last Rites Don't Wait!! If you or your loved one is ill and might wish to receive the Sacrament of the Sick, **PLEASE, do not wait until the time of death is near!** We only have one priest serving two parishes. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, often referred to as Last Rites, is a ritual of healing appropriate not only for those in immediate danger of death but also for those suffering from physical, mental, or spiritual sickness. If you know you will be hospitalized for a planned surgery, contact the parish before you enter the hospital to arrange a time celebrate the sacrament.
