



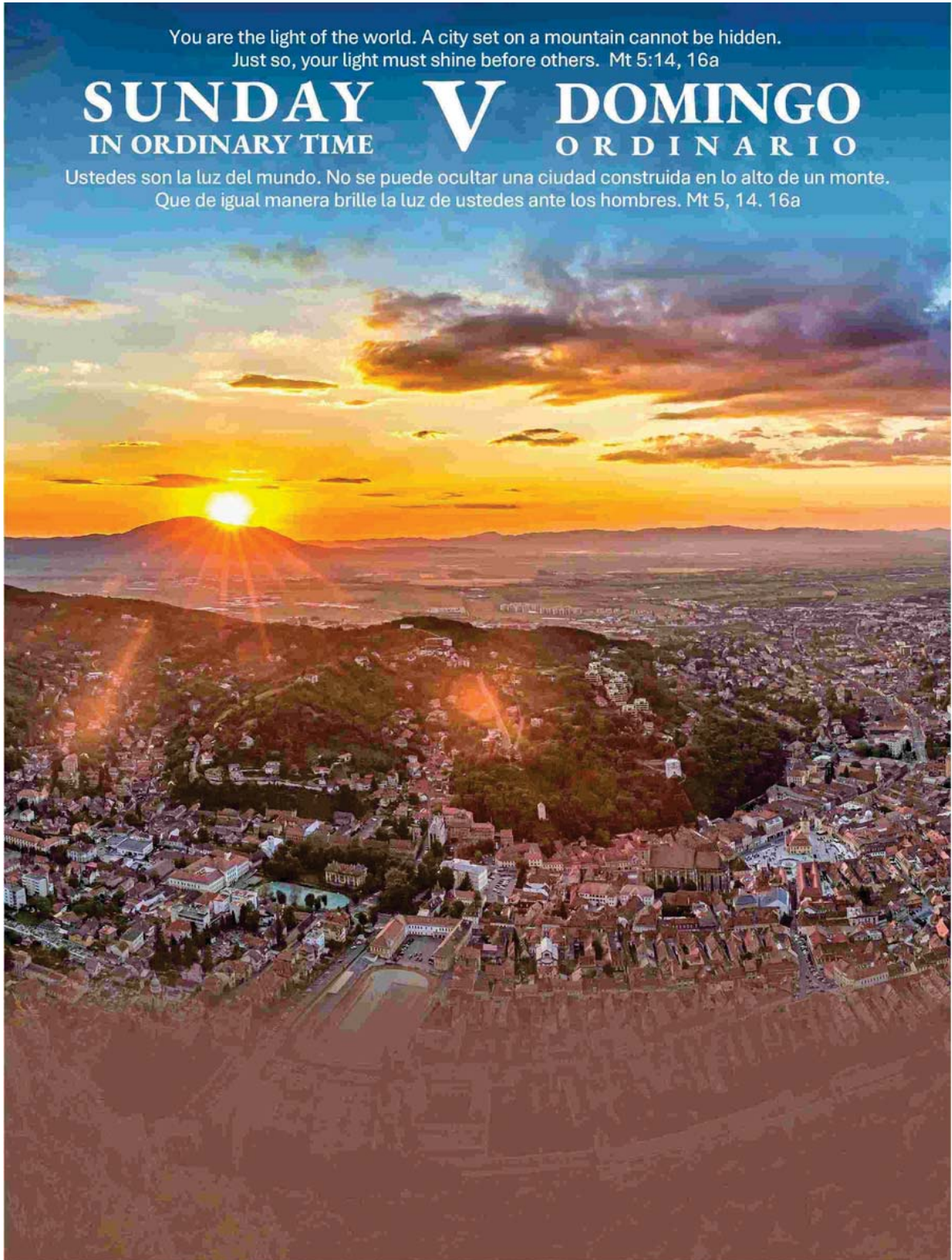

Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

It is important for us to reflect on whether our words and actions reflect the light of Christ. If they do not, what change will you make so that Christ's light shines for others to see? By doing that, you have the power to diminish the darkness that exists around you!

2026 CORI Reporting Requirement

Each year the Archdiocese of Boston requires that all priests, employees, Religious Education teachers, musicians, vocalists, lectors, Eucharistic ministers, and volunteers with unmonitored access to minors fill out a Criminal Offender Record Identification form. Forms will be available in the office and in the church sacristies. We are asking that all people who fill one of these positions fill out the form so we can forward them to the archdiocese.

Lithuanian Community

The 10:30 Mass on February 1st, 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time, was celebrated by Fr. Emmanuel Madu. Lectors were Rima Cibas and Sarunas Krukonis. Ushers were Kovas Moore and Jack McGowan. Eucharistic minister was Gabe Cunningham. Altar servers were Nomedra and Zilvinas Cunningham. Music was led by cantor Maryte Bizinkauskas, accompanied on the organ by Daiva Navickas.

Fr. Emmanuel began his sermon referring to today's 1st reading, from the prophet Zephaniah. Zephaniah exhorts the people of Judah who have lost their faith in God, and become arrogant and proud, to look to God for safety. Zephaniah reminds us of the beauty of humility. The remnant of Israel that will be restored consists of those that express confidence in God. Jesus says "blessed are the poor in spirit for theirs is the Kingdom of God. What does poor in spirit mean? To depend solely on God, not on wealth, status. God is the source of your life. God alone suffices. When you are poor in spirit you trust in God, are blessed. Do not be distracted by passing things. The humble are those who give God the ability to raise them. God realizes that we are nothing without Him. Jesus was humble, became human, submitted to being baptized by John, obeyed the parental tutelage of Mary and Joseph, washed the feet of the Apostles, and sacrificed himself on the cross. In the Magnificat, the Blessed Virgin Mary praises God. God blesses her among all women. Tomorrow we celebrate the Visitation. If we humble ourselves before God, whether we are haves or have nots, we realize that God is everything. We should rejoice and be glad as we pray for the grace of humility.

Santa Escolástica

C. 480-547
FIESTA 10 DE FEBRERO

Escolástica y su hermano, san Benito, nacieron en el seno de una adinerada familia cristiana en Nursia, Italia. Los detalles de su vida se encuentran en los Diálogos de san Gregorio Magno. Luego que Benito estableciera su monasterio en Montecasino, ella fundó un convento en Piumarola y, por muchos años, fue abadesa de ese convento. Los hermanos se encontraban una vez al año fuera de Montecasino. Durante su última reunión, Escolástica le rogó a Benito que se quedara a pasar la noche y, luego cuando el rehusó, ella le pidió ayuda a Dios. Entonces, empezó una gran tormenta y Benito tuvo que quedarse. Ellos pasaron la noche dialogando sobre las alegrías del cielo y, tres días más tarde, ella falleció. Escolástica es la santa patrona de las monjas benedictinas y de los niños convulsivos.



Saint Scholastica

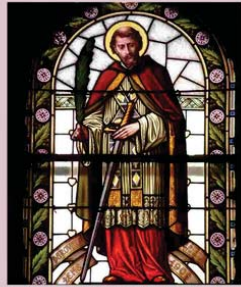
DATES: 480-547
FEAST DAY: FEBRUARY 10

Scholastica and her brother, St. Benedict, were born to a wealthy Christian family in Nursia, Italy. Details of their lives come from the Dialogues of St. Gregory the Great. After Benedict established his monastery at Monte Cassino, she founded a convent at Plombariola, and was its abbess for many years. The siblings met once a year outside Monte Cassino. At their final meeting, Scholastica begged Benedict to stay the night and, when he wouldn't, she asked God for help. A violent storm ensued and Benedict had to stay. They spent the night discussing the joys of heaven, and she died three days later. Scholastica is the patron saint of Benedictine nuns and convulsive children.



San Valentín

Aun es un misterio cómo es que el 14 de febrero se celebra como la fiesta de los enamorados. Lo poco que se sabe del homónimo de la fiesta puede ser atribuido a la vida de dos mártires: uno fue un sacerdote y, el otro, un obispo. Sus vidas no tienen nada de parecido a esta fiesta contemporánea. Cuentan que el sacerdote Valentín fue decapitado en el 269 por el Emperador Claudio II. Y, antes de eso, el obispo, conocido por sus sanaciones, había sido martirizado. Es probable que la costumbre medieval de enviar mensajes de amor en este día haya coincidido con la celebración de esta fiesta.



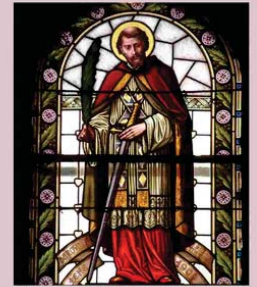

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Saint Valentine

How February 14 came to be celebrated as the feast for lovers is somewhat a mystery. What little is known of the feast's namesake can be attributed to the lives of two martyrs: one a priest, the other a bishop. Their lives bear little resemblance to the contemporary holiday. The priest Valentine reportedly was beheaded in 269 by Emperor Claudius II. The bishop, known for healing, was martyred earlier. It's probable that a medieval custom of sending messages of love on this day merged later with the feast.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

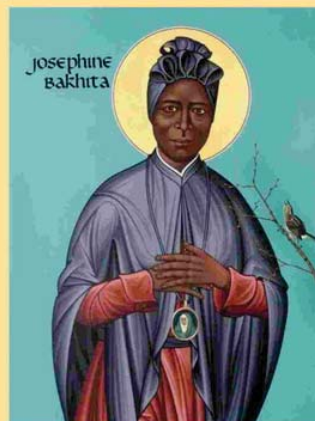

We ask for your prayers and intercessions for those enslaved among us.

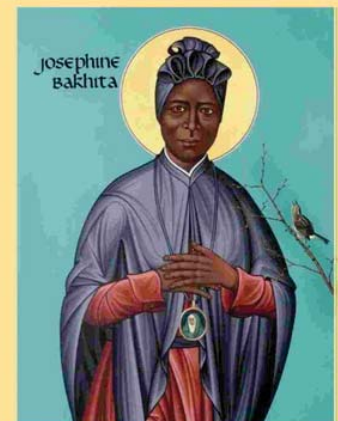

HELP CHILDREN GROW IN THE VIRTUE OF HONESTY.

My dad boldly cut to the chase when there was a lesson to be learned. If we didn't tell the truth, we heard, "A man is no better than his word, so the real cost of lying is another man's trust." Nobody likes to be lied to or deceived, so helping our children grow in the virtue of honesty is important and sometimes difficult work. Here are a few tips to help.

- **Understand the why:** There are three common reasons kids don't tell the truth. They want to win approval. They want to cover up misbehavior so they don't disappoint you. And they want to avoid punishment.
- **Dig up the root:** Once you discover the why, dig deeper for the root. If you're trying to figure out why your child told their friends you owned a beach house and a private jet, you might discover the bigger lesson is about authentic friendship.
- **Show them:** Our words and actions are powerful. Children pick up on what we say to others. If we make up a story to get out of a commitment or call in sick when we really aren't, they see that as permission to tell lies themselves. We have to model honesty if we want our kids to be honest.
- **Catch them:** Acknowledge the times they do tell the truth and act in an honest and trustworthy way. Make sure you point out how pleasing that is to the Lord.

- **Don't set them up:** If you see their blue tongue and know they are the blue sucker you told them they couldn't have, don't ask them if they ate it. Move right to the heart of the matter and say something like, "I see you ate the sucker, so your consequence will be ..."
- **Truth and love:** Call them out when they don't tell the truth, but do it in love. Scripture is full of stories like that of Zacchaeus, who wasn't honest, but, with the help of Jesus, found a way to make the situation right. Let them know being honest can be tough, but God is always there waiting to give us the grace to say and do the right thing if we ask for help.

El mundo podría hacernos pensar que nuestra tarea principal es conseguir que nuestros niños formen parte de los equipos más prestigiosos, las academias de baile más selectas o las escuelas más impresionantes. Y cuando nosotros estamos en búsqueda del mejor puesto, el primer lugar y la mejor puntuación, Jesús nos ruega que les mostremos a nuestros hijos que no hay nada más importante que darle a él, el primer lugar en nuestras vidas.

La santidad, en pocas palabras, es la unión con Dios. Aquí hay algunas cosas que podemos hacer como padres para cumplir con nuestra responsabilidad de ayudar a nuestros hijos a crecer en santidad y darle al Señor el primer lugar.

- **Reza con y por tus hijos todos los días.** Es difícil para los niños entender la importancia de Jesús y su Iglesia si rara vez hablamos de ellos.
- **Hazlo cómo yo lo hago!** Nuestros hijos imitan lo que modelamos. Necesitan vernos orar, leer las Escrituras y confiar en el Señor. Estamos enseñando lecciones cuando nos cortamos en el tráfico, cuando hablamos sobre el frustrante compañero de trabajo en la cena o cuando ponemos un sobre en la colecta del domingo

• **Mientras viajas a juegos, conciertos, recitales y eventos,** asegúrate de incluir algunos viajes a lugares realmente importantes como la misa dominical, la adoración eucarística o incluso una parada rápida para descansar del ruido y el caos en una iglesia tranquila y pacífica. Como cristianos, sabemos que Jesús siempre está con nosotros, pero una parada especial para sentirse en su presencia eucarística es buena para el alma. También muestra a nuestros hijos que Jesús es lo suficientemente importante como para detenerse.

• **Di no a las cosas que no llevan a tus hijos al cielo.** Eso podría ser canales en la pantalla, películas, música o amistades. Su santidad es más importante que tu popularidad.

• **Apuntalos a los Santos.** El mundo pone ante nuestros hijos a personas que no siempre usan sus dones y talentos para glorificar a Dios. Ya que no es muy práctico mudarnos a una cueva para proteger a nuestros hijos de todo eso, podemos bañarnos con historias de los hombres y mujeres santos de nuestra fe. Muchos de los santos vivieron vidas locas, asombrosas, aventureras y sus historias son interesantes e inspiradoras. Póngalos ante sus hijos para que sirvan como héroes y modelos a seguir.

"Bastante santo" no es una cosa. La santidad es un viaje continuo hacia el Padre, por lo tanto, mientras ayudamos a nuestros hijos a crecer en santidad, también nos encontraremos creciendo, y eso es algo muy bueno!
