The imprisoned are often an easy target. Men sit alone in cells at a maximum security prison 20 minutes away. Many incarcerated for decades. The enemy constantly whispers: "You're worthless. Forgotten. Unforgivable. Give up."

Join the fight. For over 20 years, the St. Teresa of Calcutta Prison Ministry has maintained a pen pal program - a human connection to relieve an impossibly isolated existence.

Each pen pal letter is an arrow from heaven. You're defending souls against the wickedness and snares that tend toward despair. Christ promises: "Whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me." Matthew 25:40. Every letter you send is received by Jesus himself.

It's simple. Writing takes a few minutes once a month. Your privacy is protected - all letters go through our ministry address. You use just your first name.

It's urgent. We have dozens of Catholic men waiting and hoping to get a pen pal this week.


