

Your heart needs room to keep growing; become a pen pal

You know that feeling when your world gets too small? - the same concerns, the same people, the same routines - it's busy but is it growing your heart?

Your heart is meant to keep growing

Jesus said "Be not afraid" over 80 times in the Gospels because He knew: fear keeps us small. Love makes us grow.

One letter a month to a Catholic man.

You'll write about everyday things. You'll share encouragement. You'll pray for each other. And something will shift. Your capacity for compassion expands. Your perspective deepens. You'll feel your heart making room for someone you never expected to care about. You'll feel freer.

That's the gift - not just to him, but to you.

This is "our" state prison. The men we are writing to are incarcerated in Collegetown - about 20 minutes away. We are their parish. You are their hope.

For over 20 years, the St. Teresa of Calcutta Prison Ministry has connected parishioners like you and me with Catholic inmates.

Your privacy is protected: All letters go through our ministry address; never your address. You use just your first name. We provide full support.




The one item that we are struggling to stock is - Men's Winter Coats, especially sizes: Large, X Large, XXL, XXXL and XXXXL.
