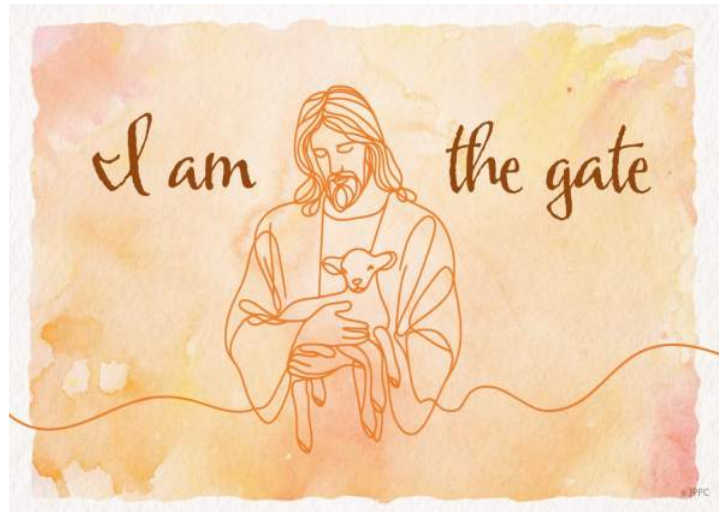

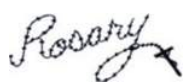
PASTOR'S CUP GOLF OUTING
