

Dear Friends,

Hope you are enjoying the summer with family and friends. Despite some hot and muggy days, it has been a seasonal summer to enjoy the outdoors and God's creation.

Parish life is a bit quieter during the summer, though we have our normal liturgical schedules and our share of weddings and funerals and daily responsibilities. I am thrilled that we're back in the parish center offices after being dislocated for three months after the pipe breakage in the upstairs kitchen in late April. The water damage afterwards was significant. We have new flooring. The offices have been painted and the ceilings restored. The office kitchen is being put back together. We have also upgraded our fire alarm system in the building. Thankfully, insurance has covered most of the expenses.

We're tackling a few other projects this summer. The roof of the old section of the school has been replaced while portions of the roof on the new section of the school were repaired. The school art room was refurnished – new flooring and painting - while the school gym floor was repaired and varnished for the new school year. Two major projects are planned for the church property – new boilers for the church (One of three boilers started to leak late Winter.) and new front steps, ramp and outdoor stairs at St. Patrick Church using Trex material. Thanks to your continued generosity and our school and parish savings, we're able to tackle these projects. Many thanks to Suzanne Beauvais and Alex Landaverde, staff members who oversee these projects. These projects help keep the school and parish buildings in good shape and make us proud to belong to Sacred Hearts Parish and/or School Communities.

Three phrases in today's readings capture my attention this week. The author of Hebrews states, "By faith Abraham obeyed...", "By faith, he sojourned in the promised land...", "By faith he received power to generate...". Abraham trusted that God would be with him and support him as he responded to God's call. God would never abandon him.

How would we complete the statement, "By faith we ..."? Some examples... By faith we accept our responsibilities in life – in marriage, as a parent, as a son/daughter to aging parents. By faith, we are guided by God to make good decisions. By faith, I know that I am a son/daughter of God and that God is always with me. By faith, God will grant me the wisdom and strength to handle life's challenging moments.

What else can we say? How would you conclude the statement? By faith, I....



Did You Know?

Did you know the beliefs of the Catholic Church rest upon two pillars, Sacred Scripture and Sacred **Tradition**? Sacred Scripture refers to the Bible, while Sacred Tradition is teachings handed on orally from the Apostles. In 2 Thessalonians 2:15 St. Paul advised the early Church to "... hold fast to the traditions that you were taught, either by an oral statement or by a letter of ours." On August 15th the Church will celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This feast commemorates the assumption of Mary's body and soul into Heaven when her earthly life ended. This belief is given to the Church as part of Sacred Tradition. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (para. 966) explains that because the Blessed Mother was preserved from any stain of original sin, she was assumed into Heaven as "a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians." In 1950 Pope Pius XII declared the Assumption of Mary as a dogma of the Catholic Church. The dogma states only that Mary was assumed body and soul into Heaven, and does not address whether her body suffered physical death, or underwent a "dormition," a sleep-state, before her assumption.


