Fall Hours

Eligibility for the Bishop LeBlond Chapter of National Honor Society

Membership in NHS is based equally upon the four standards of scholarship, service, leadership, and character. LeBlond students in the classes of 2024 and 2025 are eligible to be inducted in the fall of 2023.

To qualify for induction into the LeBlond National Honor Society, a student must have or complete the following. There are no exceptions to the quantifiable indicators, and membership is always contingent upon successful completion of <u>all</u> requirements and a positive student review by teachers and staff.

- SCHOLARSHIP: A minimum **3.5 cumulative grade point average**. This includes your GPA as of the end of the spring 2023 semester. No exceptions or rounding up. Note: any transfer hours may be calculated differently at LeBlond. Please see Mrs. Lewis with questions prior to application.
- SERVICE: Complete 18 service hours (explained on the front of this form).
- LEADERSHIP: Complete and turn in the typed **personal data sheet for nomination**.
- CHARACTER: Turn in **three recommendation sheets** from three different LeBlond teachers, coaches, or moderators. They <u>MUST</u> receive a copy of your personal data sheet for nomination with the recommendation. Also, a discipline record and academic honesty record that does not call into question the character of the applicant.

Keep the attached service hour form to log service hours completed over the summer. The other forms will be issued early in the fall semester of 2023 prior to the deadline for application later in the semester. The deadline usually takes place in early November.

Returning members for 23-24

If you were inducted as a junior in the fall of 2022, you must complete the following to remain an active member for 2023-24:

- SCHOLARSHIP: **3.5 cumulative grade point average** (see the requirements and notes above)
- SERVICE: **18 service hours** (explained on the front of this form).
- CHARACTER: Turn in **three recommendation sheets** from three different LeBlond teachers, coaches, or moderators. Also, a discipline record and academic honesty record that does not call into question the character of the applicant.
- LEADERSHIP: Remain an active member or participant in the LeBlond community. Any negative sentiments of LeBlond or the LeBlond community will not be tolerated.
