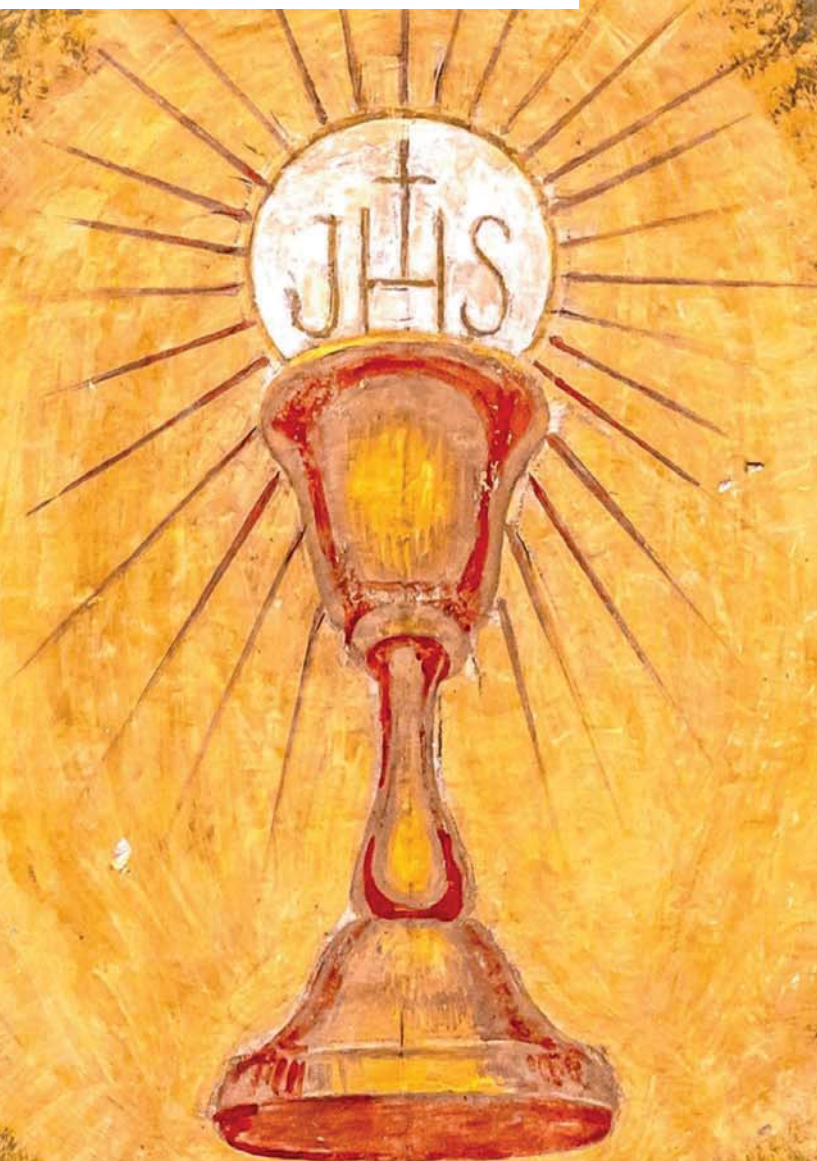

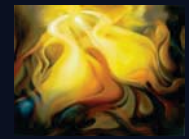

## From the Desk of Deacon Alan Doty

# The Feast of the Transfiguration



Recently, while sifting through some old papers, I stumbled upon my grandmother's naturalization papers. She arrived in the United States around 1904 from the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Her scrawled signature on the certificate (she had never learned to read or write) marked her status as a citizen of the United States.

Similarly, Baptism marks our status as citizens of heaven. Heaven is our true home, and here on earth, we are pilgrims and sojourners. The scriptures and sacred tradition serve as our guidebook, and the sacraments prepare us for our heavenly homeland.

This Tuesday, as we celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration, we catch a glimpse of what that homeland might be like. Jesus led Peter, John, and James up a mountain, where they were granted a life-changing revelation. For a few moments, they gazed upon the dazzling face of Jesus the Son, appearing in His glory. The overshadowing cloud represented the Spirit, and the voice of the Father placed the three apostles in the midst of the Trinity.

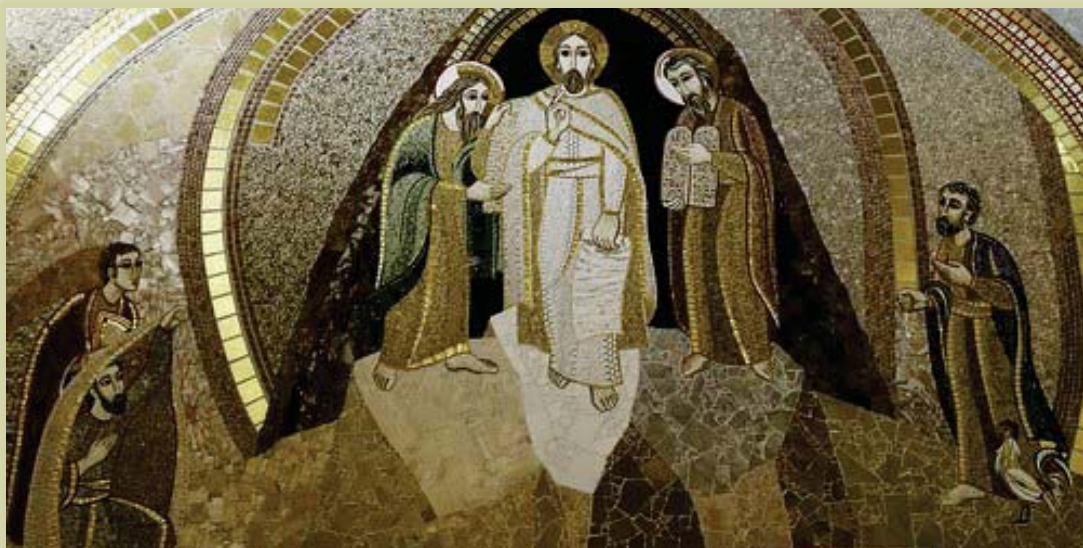
It was not a dream or vision but a breaking forth of heaven's glory into our world. This experience must have left the apostles with a deep longing for their heavenly homeland, a hunger for that realm of beauty, light, and perfection. The memory of this event gave them both a homesickness for heaven and the courage to withstand future trials. We, too, feel a homesick hunger for our true home, the home promised to us, where we will be with God and gaze upon His perfection for all eternity.

Like Peter, John, and James, we might also be granted glimpses of our

heavenly home by God's grace, perhaps in the laughter of a child, the bond of human love, or the beauty of the liturgy. In the Mass, we are transported to heaven, and in adoration, we dwell in the presence of the Lord. We feast on the Eucharist, truly bread from heaven, which gives us strength and courage for our journey.

The priorities of an earthly citizen are temporary, concerned with the things of this world. In contrast, the priorities of a heavenly citizen should be eternal, focused on things of lasting value. In this life, we strive to be illuminated by the brilliant light of the Transfiguration and encouraged in love. As citizens of heaven, we anticipate the unfading glory and beauty of the next world. We live in eager anticipation of the return of our Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. As citizens of heaven, we pray and yearn for the day when Jesus will return to transform our lowly bodies to conform with His glorified body.

Our citizenship in heaven is far more significant than my grandmother's naturalization papers, as important as they were. The Feast of the Transfiguration shows us that our true homeland is eternal and infinitely glorious, beyond what the human mind or heart can ever imagine.





## Via Pulchritudinis (The Way of Beauty)

*In this weekly series, we admire the rich Catholic symbolism present all around us at Blessed Sacrament Church.*

**Saint:** Clare **Feast Day:** August 11

**Church Location:** Right Wall, Window #7, Right Image

**Bio:** On Palm Sunday night in the year 1212, a young woman ran away from home. Clare Offreduccio wanted to follow Jesus Christ by living a radically evangelical life. Her desire for this way of life was inflamed by the preaching of a charismatic young man of Assisi named Francis Bernardone. Over her family's objections, Clare left her life of comfort to join Saint Francis in his new movement. Clare trusted in God and pledged to follow Jesus Christ in a life of total poverty.

Soon, Clare's sister Catherine joined her, and little by little more women came. They established poor convents and slowly began to spread throughout Italy and be-

yond. Their new religious order came to be known as the Poor Clares. As Clare's reputation for holiness grew, people flocked to the convent with requests for prayer. Clare struggled when Church authorities resisted the idea of a group of nuns living in complete poverty without a source of income. But she always stood firm on this point, and after great opposition, official approval of her order's Rule arrived just as Clare neared death.

### Reflection

In establishing the Poor Clares, Clare collaborated with Saint Francis in a spiritually fruitful way that shows her as a strong, wise woman. Her strength of character enabled her to withstand pressure from Church authorities who wanted her to follow a less austere way of life. The strength of Clare teaches us that the great works of God spring from the root of poverty and prayer.

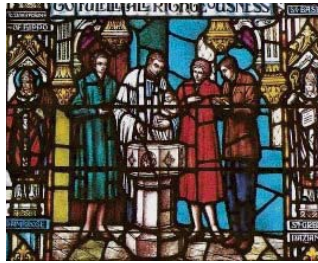


## BAPTISM REGISTRATION

Baptism is the first sacrament of Christian initiation. It is the sacrament that frees a person from original sin and makes that person a member of Christ and His Church, thus being the way to a new and spiritual life. One must be baptized before sharing in any of the other sacraments. Infants can be baptized soon after birth. At the time of baptism, parents vow to practice their faith and provide a Catholic upbringing for the child.

Group baptisms take place on the second Sunday of the month at 1pm at St. Mary's and at Blessed Sacrament on the third Sunday of the month at 12:30pm.

## A MESSAGE FROM THE BLESSED SACRAMENT CAPITAL CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE

After months of meetings of the Blessed Sacrament Capital Campaign Committee, and in response to the results of the Planning Study conducted at the end of last year, Blessed Sacrament Parish is launching the 150th Anniversary Capital Campaign!

As a result of early activity, Blessed Sacrament Parish is blessed to have received a six-figure donation and a five-figure donation. As a result of these early donations, we will begin to rebuild the front steps of the church in early August. Each parishioner will be asked to support this campaign. You will be hearing more in the upcoming weeks.

Impact to Church Operations:

1. Closure of Front Entrance: The front entrance of Blessed Sacrament will be closed from August through September 2024.
2. Alternate Access: During this period, access to the church will be through the East Street entrance and the side door that is located between the Parish Office and the church.

Alternate Venue: All weddings, funerals, and some other church activities will utilize St. Mary Church during the closure of the front entrance. However, please note that Blessed Sacrament daily and weekend masses and Private and Group Baptisms will still take place at Blessed Sacrament Church.

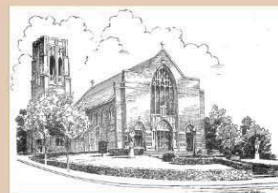

## EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### READING 1.....EX 16:2-4, 12-15

The whole Israelite community grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The Israelites said to them, "Would that we had died at the LORD's hand in the land of Egypt, as we sat by our fleshpots and ate our fill of bread! But you had to lead us into this desert to make the whole community die of famine!"

Then the LORD said to Moses,

"I will now rain down bread from heaven for you.

Each day the people are to go out and gather their daily portion; thus will I test them, to see whether they follow my instructions or not.

"I have heard the grumbling of the Israelites. Tell them: In the evening twilight you shall eat flesh, and in the morning you shall have your fill of bread, so that you may know that I, the LORD, am your God."

In the evening quail came up and covered the camp.

In the morning a dew lay all about the camp, and when the dew evaporated, there on the surface of the desert were fine flakes like hoarfrost on the ground. On seeing it, the Israelites asked one another, "What is this?" for they did not know what it was.

But Moses told them,

"This is the bread that the LORD has given you to eat."

### GOSPEL.....JN 6:24-35

When the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they themselves got into boats

And when they found him across the sea they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?"

Jesus answered them and said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled.
