From the Desk of Deacon Jim Hyatt

Inspiring and Awesome Women Saints!

Recently, I was approached by a parishioner who said, “Hey Deacon Jim, it would be really cool if you could dedicate a bulletin column to some of the most awesome holy woman and Saints throughout history!” What a great idea! So, to do that, I reached out to some of the holy women of our Collaborative and asked them to tell me which female Saints (not named the Blessed Virgin Mary) they find most inspiring. Often when we think of women Saints, we think of those who are part of a religious order. But our holy women of the Walpole were quick to point out the Saints who are, just as importantly, known for their motherhood. Let’s take a look....

Saint Monica: Born in 333, she married a pagan citizen who had a temper. Monica was first known for the trials in marriage that she bore with her husband, and her gentle conduct. She converted her husband to Christianity by her example. Her biggest trial was her son Augustine who led a wayward life. For 17 years she prayed for Augustine’s conversion which finally happened in 386. He became a Doctor of the Church! Patron Saint of mothers, wives, victims of abuse/adultery, and alcoholics.

Sarah, wife of Abraham: A canonized Saint in the Orthodox Church, laughed in disbelief when told she would bear a son in her old age (90), but later rejoiced at the fulfillment of God’s promise. Her son Isaac traveled with Abraham to a mountain in the land of Moriah, identified by some scholars as the site of the future Temple in Jerusalem. God first called Abraham to sacrifice Isaac, but at the last minute, called it off. Interesting fact – this is the same site where scholars believe Jesus was crucified. Patron Saint of laughter, infertility and in some traditions, daughters.

Saint Zélie Martin: Zélie wanted to become a nun but was turned away due to respiratory difficulties and recurrent headaches. She then prayed for God to give her many children and that they would be consecrated to God. She had nine children, but only five daughters survived, and all five entered religious life. She was canonized along with her husband in 2015, the first married

couple ever canonized together. Patron Saint of illness, mental illness, parenting and widowers. Interesting fact – one of their daughters is also a Saint, Saint Theresa of Lisieux!

Saint Theresa of Lisieux: Also known as St Theresa of the Child Jesus and the Little Flower. Virgin and Doctor of the Church. She saw herself as a simple flower in God’s garden, content to be small, yet spreading beauty and fragrance (love). Her core teaching is that sanctity isn’t achieved through grand deeds but by performing ordinary actions with extraordinary love and confidence in God. Patron Saint of missions, missionaries, florists, priests, and the sick (especially those with tuberculosis).

Saint Catherine of Siena: Virgin and Doctor of the Church. Known for her profound mystical experiences, theological writings, and powerful political influence, notably convincing the Pope to return to Rome from Avignon and mediating peace in the face of schism. Patron Saint of nurses, those ridiculed for piety, and co-patron Saint of Europe.

Saint Martha: Brother of Lazarus, sister of Mary, frequently hosted Jesus at their home. She famously confessed her belief that Jesus could raise her brother Lazarus from the dead, declaring Him the Son of God before many others would do so. She also sat at Jesus’s feet listening inventively to His teaching and represents the balance between the active, serving life and the contemplative life. Patron Saint of homemakers, servants, maids, cooks, waiters, and hotel staff.

Ruth: Important woman of the bible. The Book of Ruth is named for the Moabite woman who commits herself to the Israelite people by an oath to her mother-in-law Naomi and becomes the great-grandmother of David by marriage to Boaz of Bethlehem and thus an ancestor of Jesus.

Other Saints nominated – Saint Faustina Kowalska, Saint Mother Theresa, Servant of God Doris Day, Saint Louise de Marillac, Saint Edith Stein, and Saint Mary Magdalene.

BAPTISM REGISTRATION

Baptism is the first sacrament of Christian initiation. It is the sacrament that frees a person from original sin and makes that person a member of Christ and His Church, thus being the way to a new and spiritual life. One must be baptized before sharing in any of the other sacraments. Infants can be baptized soon after birth. At the time of baptism, parents vow to practice their faith and provide a Catholic upbringing for the child.

Group baptisms take place on the second Sunday of the month at 1pm at St. Mary's and at Blessed Sacrament on the third Sunday of the month at 12:30pm.





There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa.






