# Happy Easter from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Like me, you may be wondering: where did those 40 days of Lent go? However, most people are relieved that this long and cold winter season is finally over. Now, everyone seems to be in a better mood (I hope) and Bird Park in East Walpole is open for business. Every day, I watch people walk their dogs through the park and they seem so happy to see one another again after this long and drawn out winter.

I'm writing this to you three days before Palm Sunday, while the Catholic Church around the world is getting ready to celebrate the great feast of our salvation.

Each year, the Mother Church has given us this sacred time of Lent "for the renewing and the purifying of our hearts," as it is written in the Roman Missal.

It's a time for us to look deeply into our hearts and to examine our consciences, hopefully recognizing those dark places in our lives where we need to sweep out the stain of sins and failings that prevent us from living the true Christian life as Christ taught us.

### *The Light is On for You*

Every year during Lent, we have confessions in both parishes. It is called "the light is on for you." I have been stationed at Blessed Sacrament and have been so impressed by how many people go to Confession every Wednesday night during those 40 days of Lent. It's wonderful to see our parishioners take time out of their busy lives to go to Confession in order reconcile with God and one another. I'm amazed at the sincere faith and commitment to God.

We did not have a strong turnout at St. Mary's. I have been thinking of why this might be. The only reason I think of is because we hear Confessions there after the weekday Masses, Mondays through Wednesdays. We also hear Confessions at the 5:45 Mass on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. So, during those days, your priests are always available to hear confessions before and after Mass.

So, our wonderful friends and parishioners from East Walpole have plenty of opportunities to go to confessions during Lent and after. But the bottom line is our Collaborative is spiritually strong. Thanks be to God.

### *The Lenten Mission*

Truth to be told, I was a little bit disappointed with the number of parishioners who attended our Lenten Mission. It was only

one night of spiritual talk, Adoration and Benediction. I really wished that more parishioners came out for it. It was a rainy and cold and night so perhaps, people didn't want to come out on a lousy night like that. Next year, (God willing) we hope and pray that we will have better weather and a larger turnout.

### *Easter Sunday*

Easter is such a great event in the life of the Church and in our lives. It's the day on which our pews will be filled with new faces of people who are in town to visit their loved ones and family members and some neighbors who do not attend regularly. As you always do, please give them a warm welcome as they come in and out of our churches.

### *The Catholic Appeal*

I know that I shouldn't be talking about the Catholic Appeal on Easter Sunday. But it's another opportunity that I have given to me to remind you of your responsibilities to support Archbishop Henning in his ministry of sustaining the parish life and the mission of the greater Church.

All priests are asked to support the Catholic Appeal, too, not just parishioners. Three weeks ago, I mailed in my little contribution to the Archdiocese and got a thank you note from the Archbishop's office, thanking me for my little donation. Here's what he wrote-

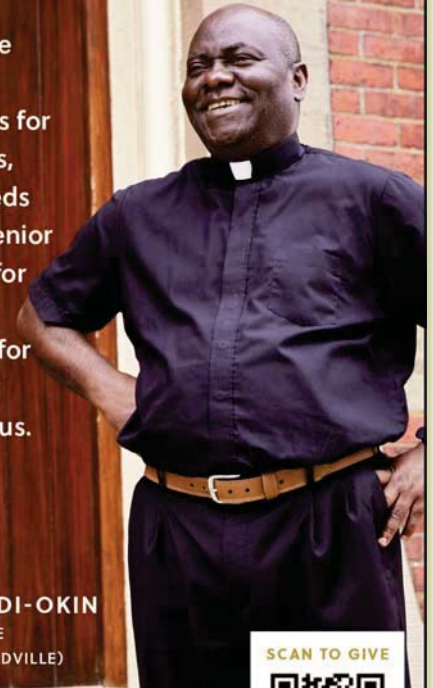
## HOMEBOUND MINISTRY

At the time of baptism, parents vow to practice their faith and provide a Catholic upbringing for the child.

## THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD— MASS OF EASTER SUNDAY

### READING 1.....ACTS 10:34A, 37-43

Peter proceeded to speak and said: “You know what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. We are witnesses of all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree. This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that he is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness, that everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name.”
