

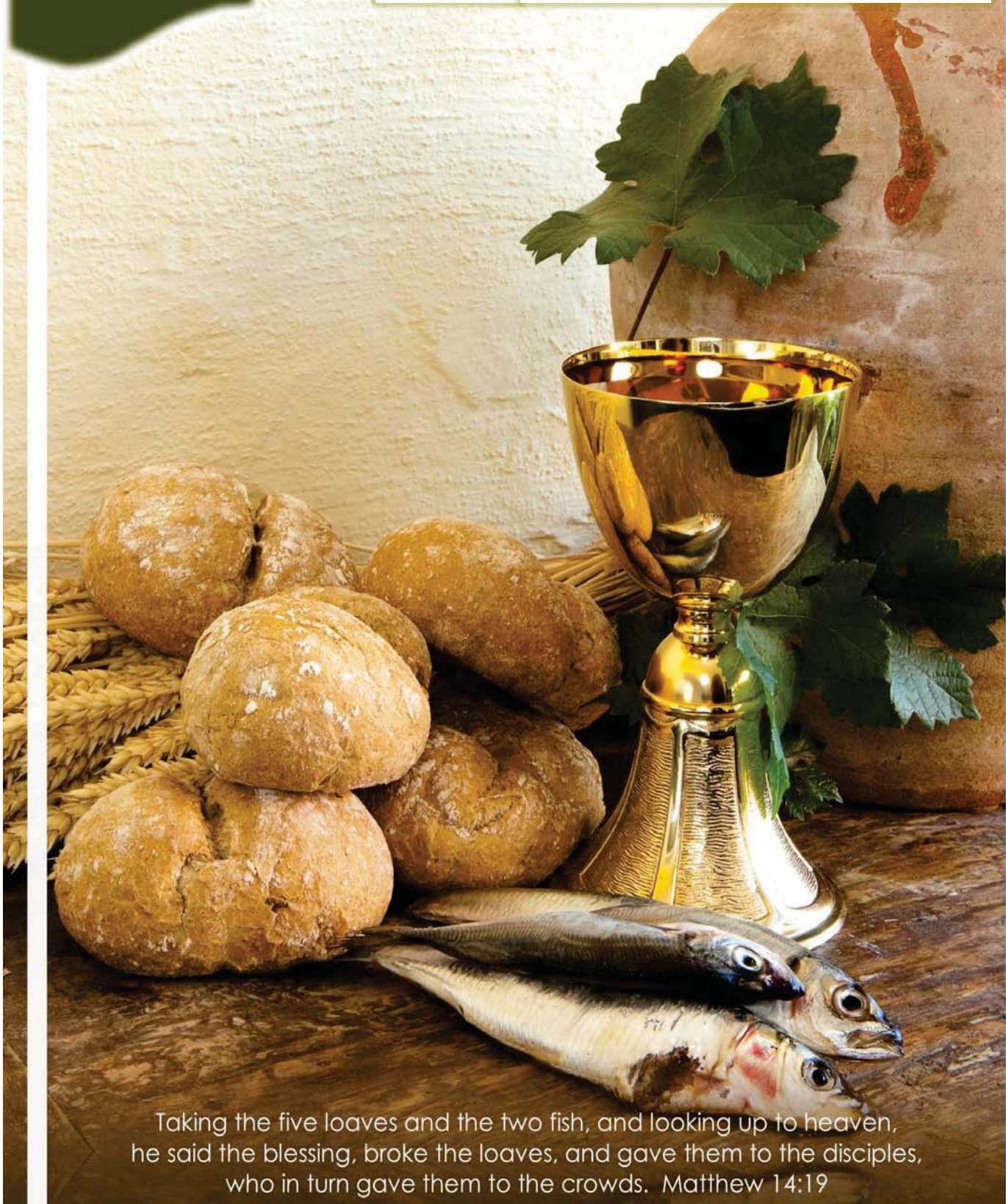

Dear Friends,

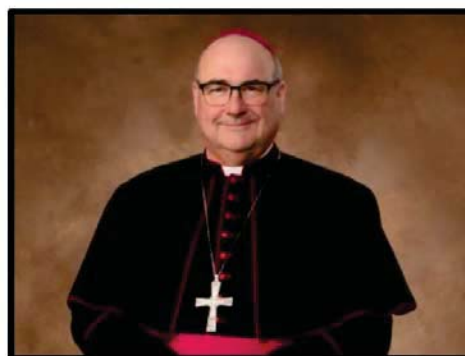

CARRYING YOUR PRAYER INTENTIONS ON THE CAMINO DE SANTIAGO

This September, pilgrims from both parishes will journey along the **Camino de Santiago**, the ancient route to the tomb of St. James. For



over a millennium, travelers have walked this path seeking renewal, healing, and deeper communion with God. Many parishioners who cannot join the pilgrimage have asked that their intentions be carried to Santiago, and the group will do so with reverence, holding each prayer close as they walk. This shared spiritual act reminds us that pilgrimage is never solitary; it is a journey made on behalf of others as well as ourselves.

Rooted in Scripture's call to "pray for one another," the practice of carrying intentions expresses the unity of the Body of Christ. Pilgrims will lift up prayers for family, friends, and even strangers. Parishioners are invited to send intentions by email (to Deacon Rey at rey.spadoni@walpolecatholic.org) or in a sealed envelope to the Blessed Sacrament office, joining the pilgrimage in spirit. In this way, the Camino becomes a shared path of faith, hope, and love for the entire community.

BAPTISM REGISTRATION

Baptism is the first sacrament of Christian initiation. It is the sacrament that frees a person from original sin and makes that person a member of Christ and His Church, thus being the way to a new and spiritual life. One must be baptized before sharing in any of the other sacraments. Infants can be baptized soon after birth. At the time of baptism, parents vow to practice their faith and provide a Catholic upbringing for the child.

Group baptisms take place on the second Sunday of the month at 1pm at St. Mary's and at Blessed Sacrament on the third Sunday of the month at 12:30pm.
