The resealing of the Blessed Sacrament parking lot has been completed. Please be aware that the parking lines will be painted in a new layout that has been designed to accommodate Blessed Sacrament school pick up and drop off, ensuring both safety and efficiency for parents and students. BAPTISM REGISTRATION

Baptism is the first sacrament of Christian initiation. It is the sacrament that frees a person from original sin and makes that person a member of Christ and His Church, thus being the way to a new and spiritual life. One must be baptized before sharing in any of the other sacraments. Infants can be baptized soon after birth. At the time of baptism, parents vow to practice their faith and provide a Catholic upbringing for the child.

Group baptisms take place on the second Sunday of the month at 1pm at St. Mary's and at Blessed Sacrament on the third Sunday of the month at 12:30pm.
