Downsizing and the Little We Actually Need

My wife and I just went through quite the process: downsizing. The kids are out of the house, and we needed to move into a smaller and easier space. It was surely time.

Time to go through all the memories, sift through the stuff that our kids don't want - which was most of it - and face the reality that moving into smaller quarters meant losing much of what we had collected through the years. For us, this was hard. Really hard.

Then, what made it even harder was an unexpected delay in moving into our new place; it was supposed to be "just a few days," but that turned into two months. Other than packing a few suitcases full of essentials, we had to quickly put everything we owned into storage. It was challenging, but it was also instructive. And if I'm being totally honest, it was good. I learned that despite all the things we've accumulated, we don't really need much to live. To truly live.

Why was it good?

First, downsizing creates more room for other things... like God. Possessions (like an overabundance of obligations and other similar "noise") can become an unhelpful distraction, a hindrance to spiritual clarity. A simpler life makes it easier to hear God's voice, notice his movement in our lives, and respond with greater freedom. As followers of Christ, we are called to live lightly and without attachments.

Second, downsizing frees us from the burden of excess. Possessions require maintenance, attention, storage, and emotional energy. Jesus tells us: "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Third, downsizing encourages generosity. When we share, others may flourish. I'm reminded of St. Ambrose's statement: "If you have two shirts in your closet, one belongs to you and the other to the man with no shirt." I take some comfort in knowing that

many items gathering dust in our home are now being put to good use by those who truly need them.

Fourth, this process can help us release our grip on, and dependence on, material security. As a result, we can learn how to rely more fully on God's providence. In short, it helps us realize that God is enough.

Fifth - and I can certainly relate to this based on how life has been over the past few months - getting rid of our excess can spark greater inner peace. I've been feeling lighter, calmer, and more grounded.

And finally, downsizing helps prepare us for mission. A simpler and less cluttered life can prompt us to become more available for the work God is calling us toward.

Downsizing, in the end, is not about losing anything... it's about uncovering what has been waiting beneath the noise all along, finding the calmer water under the waves. When we choose a simpler life, we step closer to the heart of the Gospel, where freedom, generosity, and trust in God shape who we truly are more than possessions or busyness ever could. In letting go, we make room for grace; in living lightly, we walk more steadily in Christ's footsteps.

Downsizing becomes a quiet but powerful act of faith, a way of saying with our lives that God is enough.

My wife and I are not fully through this process. There are boxes galore here and more stuff to sift through. But we're getting there...

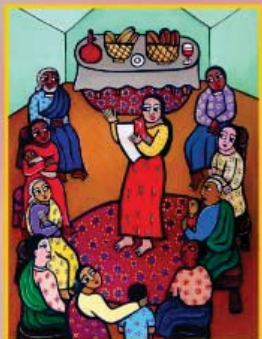
CLOTHING FOR THE HOMELESS
