# TENDING GOD'S FLOCK

# Karen Robben | 03 April 2023 Third Sunday of Easter



- 1. In Fr. Glenn's March 5 "Tending God's Flock", he mentioned that feedback received at our February Town Halls indicated that additional **Faith Formation classrooms** should be one of our highest priorities, potentially as mobile units. To help us discern our path forward, we invited Hung Pham, the Executive Director of Construction for the Diocese of St. Petersburg, to St. Thomas on March 20 to discuss the various approaches that we could take to meet our needs. We are following his recommendations and gaining additional data that will drive and inform our next steps. Stay tuned for further updates.
- 2. We set out to deepen our faith, as we journeyed through this past Lent. There was the "Best Lent Ever" and "Holy Moments", Stations of the Cross, and our Lenten Retreat with Benedictine monk and priest Rev. Lucius Amarillas, which was very well attended. The recurrent theme I found through all of this was **forgiveness**, and perhaps the most poignant was the forgiveness Jesus gave to those who were crucifying him. Jesus didn't forgive them with his last breath or when he rose from the dead. No, Jesus forgave his persecutors while they were persecuting him: "Father, forgive them, they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34). Jesus still offers his forgiveness today through his priests, for in the confessional, Jesus is there pouring out his mercy and love to all who ask.



3. In today's **gospel** (Lk 24:13-35), we encounter two of Jesus' disciples on the road to Emmaus. They headed out on the first day of the week, and during their walk, "Jesus himself drew near and walked with them". Jesus walked with them on the seven mile journey to Emmaus. He didn't watch them from a distance; he entered their lives and began a conversation with them. Jesus does the same for us. He is our companion on our journeys, and he will guide us and reveal himself to us if only we open our eyes.






