

TENDING GOD'S FLOCK

11 June 2023 | Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, Year A Fr. Glenn | 24 April 2023



1. We begin today the **second phase of the National Eucharistic Revival**, which covers from June 11, 2023, until July 16, 2024. At this stage, the revival happens in the parishes, with the assistance of "Eucharistic missionaries" who are described as parish lay leaders that help in organizing and carrying out the revival at the parish level. As of this writing, however, we are still waiting for the playbook from the diocese that will give us the concrete steps to make during the parish revival. But even before the advent of this playbook, here in our parish, we have already been doing the following: Eucharistic adoration every Thursday after mass, more catechesis on the Eucharist through homilies and retreats, and revival of classic Eucharistic hymns for mass.

2. We celebrate today the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as **Corpus Christi Sunday**. Weather permitting, we will publicly display our faith in the Eucharist by holding a procession of the Blessed Sacrament outside our church in one of our masses this weekend. To feed on Christ, our Living Bread, means not only being bonded to Christ and one another at the Eucharistic celebration, but also bringing our Living Bread to the streets. If we become what we eat, then every aspect of our lives should reflect that.



3. In today's **gospel** (John 6:51-58), Jesus tells those who were following him: "The bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." But they did not understand. They thought that Jesus was advocating cannibalism. The response of Jesus is even more shocking: "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day." In other words, the fullness of life belongs to those who fully and actively experience Christ by partaking of his Body and Blood in the Eucharist.





In May, through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul brought the love and care of Jesus to the Poor by assisting families and providing food. 
