

25 June 2023 | Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time, Year A




- 1. In a prior TGF, Fr. Glenn mentioned, that as of Corpus Christi, we are in the 2nd year of the National Eucharistic Revival, where the focus is at the parish level. At our **annual planning meeting** on May 24, the pastoral staff spent time discussing what we could do to increase the understanding and reverence of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and grow in our faith. While some logistics need to be finalized, we are planning to celebrate Mass in the evening once a week; conduct an evening bible study; train and commission all of our liturgical ministers; continue and expand our Holy Hours; and more. We welcome your input! Please send me an e-mail at KarenR@MyStThomas.org if you have any suggestions or would like to volunteer.
- 2. Did you know that the **church is open** Monday through Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for personal prayer time? Access to the church is available through the rear door, directly across from the entrance to the office, and you are always welcome to visit Jesus in the tabernacle one of the great Catholic traditions. Jesus is truly present, body, blood, soul and divinity, and He is waiting for you to visit Him. It doesn't have to be a lengthy visit or include a formal prayer. In the words of St. John Vianney, patron saint of priests, "We know that Jesus is there in the tabernacle: let us open our hearts to Him, let us rejoice in His Sacred Presence. That is the best prayer."
- 3. In today's **gospel** (Mt 10:26-33), we receive an invitation from Jesus to "speak in the light" and boldly proclaim his message. In these eight verses, Jesus tells us three times not to be afraid, as if to say, "do you hear me now?" Jesus wants to assure us that in whatever challenge we face, we should have fear of no one and nothing, except for the fear of God. Rather, we should remember that we are all precious to our heavenly Father, who knows us intimately and cares for us beyond measure.



In the storms of life, we turn to God and pray that we will be spared from harm. We are also called to take the necessary precautions to protect the precious gift of life and to minimize damage to property.

Take Shelter

If you are elderly or have special needs, please contact your county's Emergency
Management Office to preregister prior to any storm if you will need to evacuate.

Use Good Judment

Use good judgment when deciding if conditions are safe to travel to Mass. In the event that roadways are not clear and weather conditions are unsafe to travel, the faithful are reminded that the obligation to participate in the Sunday Mass does not apply when there is grave difficulty in fulfilling this obligation (Code of CanonLaw, Canon 1248 §2).

If a storm threatens our area, please check local news stations for weather updates. Also, check with your parish and school about about closures and cancellations. Also, check the diocesan website, www.dosp.org.
