




# **TENDING GOD'S FLOCK**

9 July 2023 | 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year A



- 1. **CMA at work:** The 18-unit St. Benedict Apartments in Crystal River are finally ready for occupancy. Under Catholic Charities' Shelter of Hope initiative, the Diocese of St. Peterburg has built affordable, income-based rental apartments for individuals and families in various parts of the diocese. Located at 6753 W Gulf to Lake Highway (Crystal River), this is the first Shelters of Hope housing project in Citrus County. Grand opening is set for July 11 (Tuesday), with Bishop Gregory Parkes attending. These Shelters of Hope are just one of the many projects that our diocese is doing using the contributions we donate to the Catholic Ministry Appeal (CMA). Thank you for your continued support.
- 2. Last June 11th, Corpus Christi Sunday, we began the second and most critical phase of the National Eucharistic Revival (NER). This phase is focused on revival in the parish level. For this reason, we have started some **initiatives** to foster eucharistic revival in our parish. Ongoing NER initiatives: Holy Hour every Thursday (8:30 a.m. 9:30 a.m.); missions and retreats focused on the Eucharist; Eucharistic processions. Starting in September, we are offering an evening mass during the week for those unable to attend the morning mass. If this gains some traction, then we will offer more evening activities, such as bible study, adoration, etc.
- 3. In today's **gospel** (Matthew 11:25-30), Jesus invites us: "Come to me, all who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest." Life could get burdensome at times. Whatever type of burden we carry, Jesus assures us that we are never alone, for he walks with us, and he shares our burdens. Following the example of Jesus, we have to help one another in carrying our burdens in life. In Jesus, we have a God who shares our yoke. In Jesus, we have a God who is meek and humble of heart. In Jesus, we have a God who invites us to find rest in him.






