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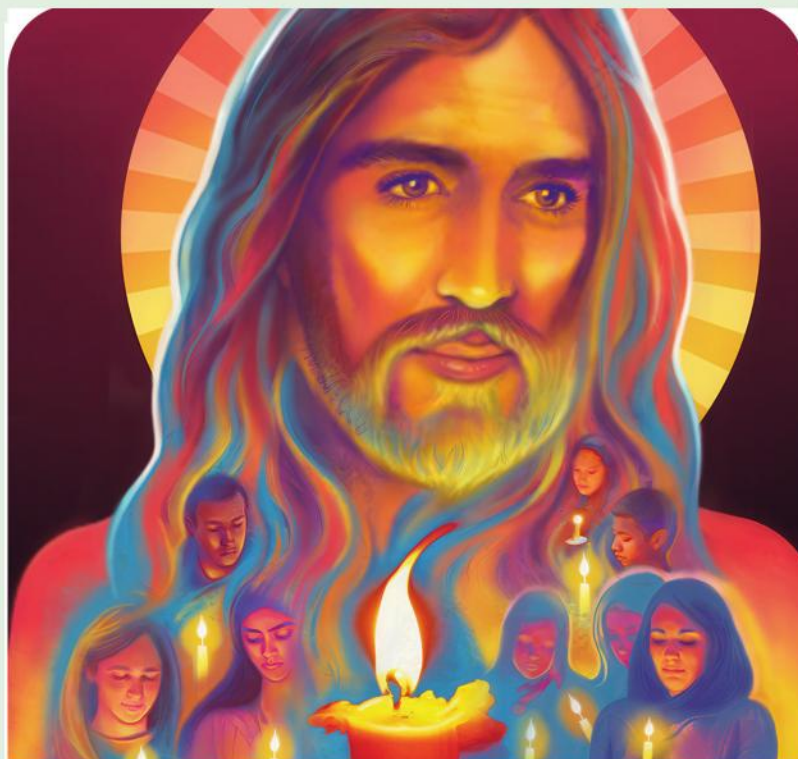

FROM FATHER MIKE DEL PADRE MIGUEL



These next two weeks give us two remarkable passages from Luke's gospel, and two stories that are not found in the other three gospels. First is the story commonly called "The Good Samaritan," a parable that Jesus uses to illustrate the love of neighbor by depicting a foreigner who is more

caring to a crime victim than even a priest. The second is the story of Martha and Mary, where Mary, listening to Jesus, has chosen the better part over Martha, who is busy with the details of hospitality.

A way to see both of these stories as connected is to notice the way in which Luke leads into them. First comes his story of the scholar of the law, who correctly answers the question, "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" His response to Jesus' inquiry is to refer to the Great Commandment, namely that we are to love God and to love our neighbor as ourselves. Jesus then gives the examples of people who better demonstrated a love of neighbor (the Good Samaritan) and who had a better focus on loving God (Mary instead of Martha).

I find looking at these two passages together helpful because they express both our desire to being loving people in general but the reality that we still fall short in the particulars of actually loving God and others. No one likes to think of themselves as unfaithful to Christ or unkind to others, but Luke is gently inviting us to consider the fact that maybe we do not live up to the expectations we set for ourselves nor to the commandment given to us by Jesus.

Interestingly, the next passage after these two, Luke tells of Jesus teaching his disciples to pray. It is here that Jesus gives them the "Our Father" prayer, which includes a reference to forgiveness. Perhaps during these summer weeks is a good time for us to review our life, renew our desire to be better at loving God and others, and to pray for the strength to fulfill Jesus' Great Commandment and for reconciliation with God for when we have not lived up to his Law of Love.

Estas próximas dos semanas nos presentan dos pasajes notables del evangelio de Lucas, y dos historias que no se encuentran en los otros tres evangelios. La primera es la historia comúnmente llamada "El Buen Samaritano", una parábola que Jesús utiliza para ilustrar el amor al prójimo al presentar a un extranjero que muestra más compasión hacia una víctima de un crimen que incluso un sacerdote. La segunda es la historia de Marta y María, donde María, al escuchar a Jesús, ha escogido la mejor parte en comparación con Marta, quien está ocupada con los detalles de la hospitalidad.

Una forma de ver estas dos historias como conectadas es notar cómo Lucas las introduce. Primero viene la historia del doctor de la ley, quien responde correctamente a la pregunta: "¿Qué debo hacer para heredar la vida eterna?" Su respuesta a la pregunta de Jesús es referirse al Gran Mandamiento, es decir, que debemos amar a Dios y amar al prójimo como a nosotros mismos. Jesús luego ofrece ejemplos de personas que demostraron mejor el amor al prójimo (el Buen Samaritano) y quienes tuvieron un enfoque más acertado en el amor a Dios (María en lugar de Marta).

Me resulta útil observar estos dos pasajes juntos porque expresan tanto nuestro deseo de ser personas amorosas en general como también la realidad de que aún fallamos en los detalles concretos de amar realmente a Dios y a los demás. A nadie le gusta pensar que es infiel a Cristo o que es poco amable con los demás, pero Lucas nos invita suavemente a considerar el hecho de que tal vez no vivimos a la altura de las expectativas que nos hemos puesto ni del mandamiento que Jesús nos ha dado.

Curiosamente, el pasaje siguiente a estos dos es cuando Lucas narra que Jesús enseña a sus discípulos a orar. Es allí donde Jesús les da la oración del "Padre Nuestro", que incluye una referencia al perdón. Quizás durante estas semanas de verano sea un buen momento para revisar nuestra vida, renovar nuestro deseo de mejorar en el amor a Dios y al prójimo, y orar por la fortaleza para cumplir con el Gran Mandamiento de Jesús y por la reconciliación con Dios cuando no hemos vivido según su Ley del Amor.

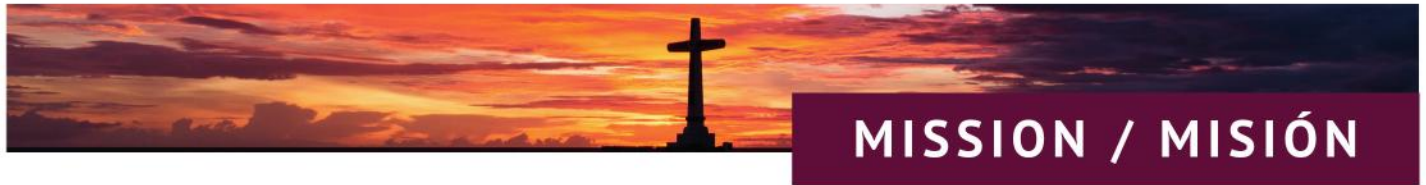

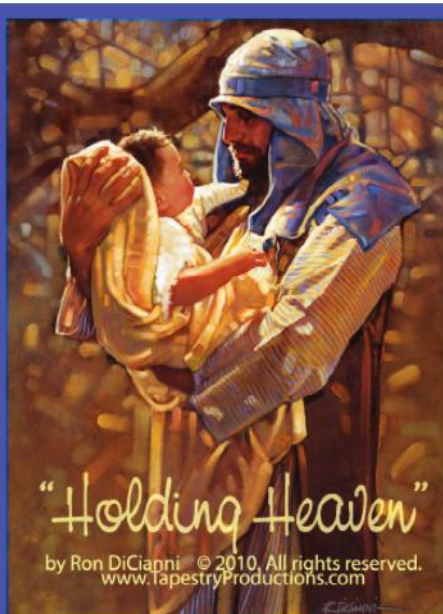
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
