FROM FATHER MIKE DEL PADRE MIGUEL



You will notice that our parishes, like many these days, uses the term "Faith Formation" instead of "Religious Education" or "Sunday School" or "CCD" (Confraternity of Catholic Doctrine). We also refer to "sessions" instead of "classes," and "participants" instead of "students."

Why all the fuss about nomenclature?

The language we use shapes our perception, and our perception can change our experience. For example, someone approaches us who is not Catholic and wants to check us out is certainly interested in learning more about what we believe. Sometimes they have already addressed those questions as there is a wealth of information on the internet these days. But I believe what they are also looking for is a community of people who support each other, who understand and believe in what our church teaches, and whose daily lives are rooted in this conviction.

When we are being formed in the faith, we are engaging our entire being in the ongoing work of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. Part of that is acquiring more information about God, the Bible, Church teachings, and other aspects of the content of our faith. But we also are formed in our participation in the sacraments, our personal prayer and devotional life, our interaction with other Catholics, and many other ways that help grow in living out our relationship with Jesus.

Faith formation is not just for young people. This is why even with our youth we are offering more opportunities for the entire family to have a shared experience in growing together in the Lord. We continue to offer formation for adults to better apply the scriptures to their daily life, to deepen their prayer life, and to be better equipped for their particular parish ministry. Just this year we have had more than 150 adults who in various ways have actively worked at developing to be better disciples. What a blessing!

Notarán que nuestras parroquias, como muchas en estos tiempos, utilizan el término "Formación en la Fe" en lugar de "Educación Religiosa", o "La Doctrina". También hablamos de "sesiones" en lugar de "clases", y de "participantes" en vez de "estudiantes". ¿Por qué tanta insistencia con la nomenclatura?

El lenguaje que usamos afecta nuestra percepción, y nuestra percepción puede transformar nuestra experiencia. Por ejemplo, cuando alguien que no es católico se acerca para conocernos, ciertamente tiene interés en aprender más sobre lo que creemos. A veces ya han investigado esas preguntas por causa que hay una gran cantidad de información en internet. Pero creo que lo que también buscan es una comunidad de personas quienes se apoyen mutuamente, quienes comprendan y crean en lo que enseña la Iglesia, y cuyas vidas diarias estén fijados en esa convicción.

Cuando estamos siendo formados en la fe, estamos comprometiendo toda nuestra persona en el trabajo continuo de ser discípulos de Jesús. Parte de ese proceso incluye aprender más conocimiento sobre Dios, la Biblia, las enseñanzas de la Iglesia, y otros aspectos del contenido de nuestra Fe. Pero también somos formados a través de nuestra participación en los sacramentos, en la oración personal, en la vida devocional, en nuestra interacción con otros católicos, y en muchas otras maneras que nos ayudan a crecer en nuestra relación con Jesús.

La formación en la fe no es solo para los jóvenes. Por eso, incluso con nuestra juventud, ofrecemos más oportunidades para que toda la familia tenga una experiencia compartida de crecimiento en el Señor. Continuamos ofreciendo formación para adultos, para que puedan aplicar mejor las Escrituras a su vida diaria, profundizar en su vida de oración y estar mejor preparados para su ministerio particular en la parroquia. Solo este año, más de 150 adultos han trabajado activamente de diversas formas en crecer como discípulos. ¡Qué bendición!

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VICTIM ASSISTANCE MINISTRY- REPORTING AN INCIDENT

WHO SHOULD MAKE A REPORT

- Victims of child sexual abuse by a person ministering on behalf of the Church
- Persons with a suspicion that a child may be sexually abused by a person ministering on behalf of the Church
- Persons concerned about violations about our Code of Conduct regarding appropriate behavior with children by any person ministering on behalf of the Church

HOW TO MAKE A REPORT

- 1.If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by clergy (priest or deacon) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner: Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement.
- 2.Call Jackie Montrie M.A., LMFT, LMHC Victim Assistance Coordinator of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana at (765) 464-4988.
- 3.Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse in the past or present day by someone working in a parish or school for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as religious sister or brother, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- 1.Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556 or local law enforcement
- 2.Call our Ethics Hotline 855-375-6796, or go to dioceseoflafayetteinindiana.ethicspoint.com. OR
- 3.Call Jeanne Lausten, Director of Human Resources at 765-269-4604.

- 3.A partir de entonces, se llevará a cabo una investigación por, o en nombre de, la Diócesis de Lafayette-en-Indiana.
