

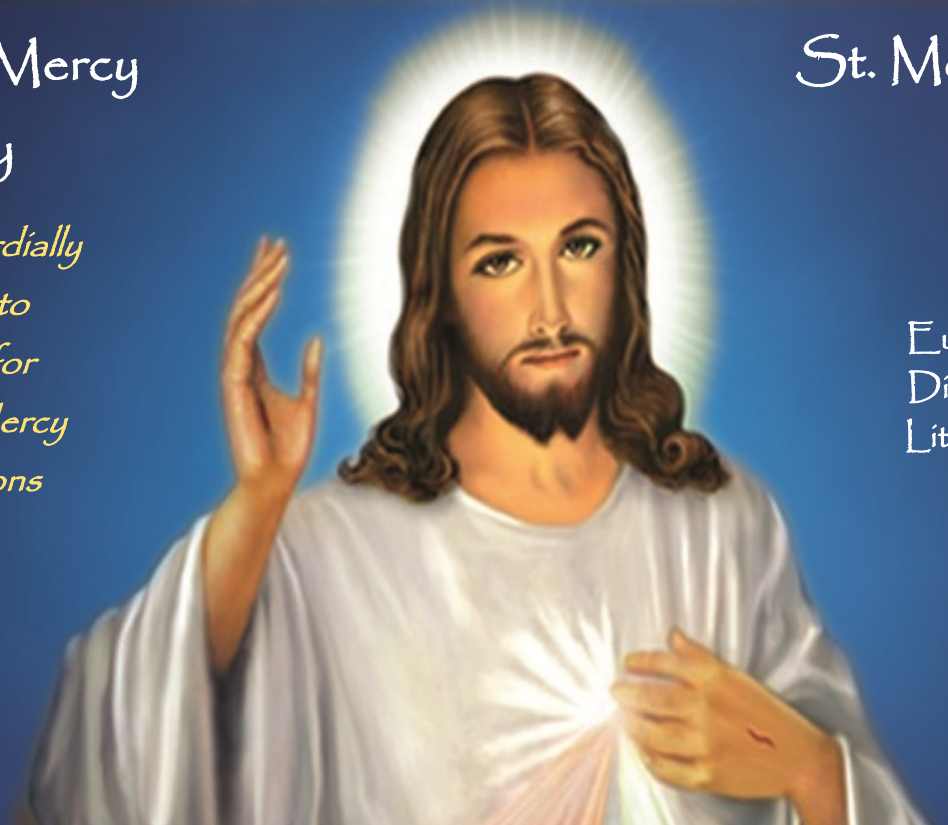

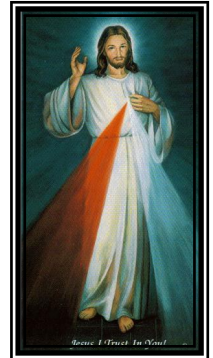

To the parents of our young children, may we suggest...

Relax! God put the wiggle in children, don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads.

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc.

Sing the hymns, pray the prayers and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you need to leave Mass with your child, please feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."

Remember that the way we welcome children into the Church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.

To comply with the policies and procedures set forth by the Diocese of Kalamazoo, the following information is run once per month in parish bulletins: The Diocese of Kalamazoo has and will continue to co-operate with the Michigan Attorney General's investigation and encourages anyone with information related to misconduct to call the reporting number set-up by the Michigan Attorney General's office at: 844-324-3374. To report allegations of sexual abuse of minors or vulnerable adults within the Diocese of Kalamazoo by priests, deacons or other employees or volunteers, regardless of when it occurred, individuals should contact local law enforcement or the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services at 855-444-3911. The Catholic Bishop Abuse Reporting Service (CBAR) has been established to receive reports of sexual abuse and related misconduct by bishops and to relay those reports to proper Church authorities for investigation. To make a report, visit ReportBishopAbuse.org or phone 800-276-1562. When a report includes a crime, such as the sexual abuse of a minor, it will also be reported to civil authorities. Otherwise, reports will be kept confidential.
