- Follow up on discussion from Pastoral Care Council regarding sponsorship for Sarah's Table decision was made to not solicit a sponsor and to maintain costs within the parish. Other ideas to help subsidize costs to vendor: offer a letter from St. Odilia to Little Venetian indicating cost/expense to support a tax write off. Another option is to review/modify menu items.

Pastor's Report Fr. Erich R.

- Fr. Erich thanked PLC members for their work and participation over the several months with facilitator June Klaphake on the Mission and visioning process.
- Central mission given to us by Jesus himself: "Go and make disciples." Our own Archdiocesan mission statement expresses this same idea: "Make Jesus Known and Loved". To take on this mission helps align us with our Archdiocese and the universal Church. St Odilia Vision: "The Church on fire with the Holy Spirit and a world transformed in Jesus Christ." This is why we exist. This is what we are here to create.

- Campus Space Will be meeting with contractors to discuss options on how best to utilize/repurpose the 3510 Vivian building.
- Building Security Facilities manager, Mark Kolasa, attended a meeting on church safety & security.
 Progress is being made. New Courtyard security system is in place. Virtus training through the Archdiocese for staff and volunteers. Planning to do more consulting on the school and parish side.

- Financial Review YTD reviewing budget prior to end-of-year, plate giving is off by about 20%. Contributing factors include a month that has 5 Sundays vs 4. Christmas is on a Sunday this year.
- Current healthy reserve balance, however we need to be prudent on how we use the reserve. School, preschool, faith formation programming are all going well. We approved a budget deficit. We are intentionally investing in areas where we want to see growth.
- Parishioner Engagement Coordinator position hired Theresa Kruse (part time). Will focus on ways to enhance the Sunday experience, reinvigorate our parishioner engagement.

Come Back to Mass Event / Campaign

Amy E. / All

- Several discussions about a "come back to Mass" event in November, or during Advent. Discussed creative
 ways to reach parishioners and the wider community via mailing, social media, newspapers, dropping off
 mailers in large complexes. Discussed idea of an on-going campaign around "Home for the Holidays".
- Needs to be properly planned and executed. We want to have a good presence when families are here at
 Mass. Cross-effort with parish and school. Invite families to Mass during Catholic Schools week, celebration of
 60 years of the school, other events that will bring families together. Greeters at Mass. We need to do an
 evangelization effort. Go to where the people are, outreach.
- Opportunity to re-launch the Parish App. Another avenue for reaching our parishioners.
- Amy will provide a recommendation for PLC next month, including a timeline, action plan for a "come back to Mass" campaign.

- Looking at optimizing space usage including 3510 Vivian building to accommodate future growth.
- New security system on the Courtyard doors entering the school.
- Reducing cost with janitorial supplies (switching supplier) and camera/door vendors.

- As of September 30, 2022, our contributions are \$109k below budget. This a concern because we had planned a deficit budget to increasing funding of needed programs.
- The Investment Policy Statement (IPS) for St. Odilia Long Term Reserve funds was revised in order to make it consistent Short Term IPS.

Pastoral Care Council Karen H.

- Sarah's Table served 80 seniors in October. Upcoming dates are November 16 and December 14. To keep the cost of the meal reasonable to participants, any potential subsidy will be in our 2023/24 budget.
- Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) was attended by 22 St. Odilia Volunteers. Upcoming events are November 2 and December 6.
- Dementia Friendly parish the next Mass for those affected by Memory Loss and their Care Givers is November 17 at 1:30. Father Skrypec will perform the service. This Mass is open to all parishes. A reception will be held after Mass for discussion and information.
- Donation Bin collection a specially constructed wooden bin will be placed in the south entry for convenience and additional collection. October collections are for Appalachia and Women's Life Care Center. A three-week November collection will be for Brittney's House. November and December collections are for Sharing & Caring Hands and Sp.R.Ed teen gifts. Birthright (CCW) will have a special baby collection in January.
- The first year of the community garden was successful in providing vegetables for the community. Next year's garden goals will be expanded to provide student education and further parishioners' participation.
