- Sharing Tree
 - Dallas & Linda Schute and Frank & Mary Ann Petron set up and decorated tree; ornaments with gift card suggestions made by school children.
 - Typically \$12-15,00 in gift cards are collected to be distributed at Christmas and throughout the year.
- Thanksgiving Boxes
 - 40 boxes distributed some were picked up and Sandy Cortez delivered others to those in Latino community.
- Cards for Seniors
 - All agreed that we will again send out cards before Easter.
 - Will discuss age cut off, since some feel 80 is too "young".
 - Would like names of couples to be collated rather than just individual
- Food Shelf
 - 500 lbs of food collected over Thanksgiving
 - Amy keeps a record of pounds/bags of food collected and donated to each food shelf.
 - Now have 2 permanent volunteers to deliver food that alternate weeks (Karen and Bob), plus a back up.

 - Will discuss the possibility of adding days beyond the 5th Wednesday.
