Pastor's Report Fr. James P.

- Synod: going forward with small group training on Tuesday evening. 57 members from Latino
 community, 33 English. 90 in total. Recently attended a priest formation day about the synod process,
 Parish Evangelizing Cells (PECS). Will offer at a larger level in the spring.
- Attended an event at the Cathedral, relics of St. Therese of Lisieux, universal patroness of the foreign
 missions, and her saintly parents. Thousands of people present, giving thanks and praise to God and to
 venerate the relics of these great saints.

Administrator's Report Rick S.

- Annual Financial Report is complete.
- Prayer Garden: Lynne Schriver-Sheedy manages the prayer garden. She will join PLC next month to give an update on the Prayer Garden financials and where we are with the expansion/adding columbaria.

- Promoted Faith Formation programs at the Ministry Fair. Youth ministry is building. Spark Nights going well with approx 16 kids. Metanoia (High School Youth Group) has a core group of 6-8 students.
- Looking to start giving recommendations for content on Formed. Plan to solicit reviews from parishioners.

- December ad-hoc meeting to review tuition for 2024-2025, will look at structure and organization of the school.
