Administrator's Report Rick S.

- Cottage place sub-committee made of parishioners/parish & school staff/MAC members acting as a sounding board for the PLC/Pastor, working with the city of Shoreview.
- 2024 distribution from the St. Odilia Endowment Fund numbers will be similar to what they were last year. \$87,500 for Parish, \$26,900 for School (includes Connor Anderson School Scholarship Fund). Money will be used in fiscal year 2025.
 - o Two separate endowment funds: St. Odilia Endowment and St. Odilia School Endowment
 - Requesting grants from Ministry Area Councils: during the month of March, councils should work together to determine grant requests, may want to partner with other councils and submit joint requests.
 Grant applications submitted to Rick Storms by April 6. PLC will review mid-April and grants will be available July 1, 2024.
 - o Information on distribution guidelines and grant request applications will be emailed to all councils in February. Any questions on the Endowment distribution process can be sent to Rick Storms.
- May month of discernment. Not too early to start thinking about your council members, who may be the person to join your council, what is the future of your council?
 - Informational meeting schedule for April 28, after the 9am Mass. Idea from PLC: host an informational meeting in the Courtyard. Need to promote more widely to gain interest/share information on each MAC.
