A percentage of contributions benefit our parish.</p> <p><u>Administrator's Report</u> Second Discernment Information Day - May 19 after all masses. All MACs are requested to have a volunteer to be available to share their experiences/knowledge about being a ministry council. Of the endowment grants requested by the councils, 28 requests were approved.</p> <p><u>Worship Council</u> Parishioners enjoyed the Mission Speaker. There were 3,092 participants in the Easter Masses.</p> <p><u>Facilities Council</u> A new item for repair is the resurfacing of the parking lots which will be a 2-3 year project.
