#### **Administrative Update**

**Rick S.**

- We will pause the recruiting process for a Parish Administrator until further notice. Rick will delay his retirement for now, date TBD. We have received a positive response for the open position, with approx. 5-10 candidates who may be a good fit. We will inform the candidates that the process is on hold for now, but we don't anticipate this pause to negatively impact their interest.
- The archdiocese will conduct a safety training session. The Department of Homeland Security has specialists dedicated to assessing safety in schools and places of worship. A safety assessment will be carried out.
- May research an AI program that will assist in taking minutes.
- Any updates from the Woodworkers Guild? Meetings with Catholic Mutual have been postponed, and discussions have yet to take place. We need to coordinate with Catholic Mutual to schedule a meeting and explore the possibility of utilizing rented space.

<b>Social Justice Council 3</b>	<b>Beth A.</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>SJC submitted two grant requests to the Catholic Community Foundation. We received funding for one: \$4,000 for a food program.</li><li>A meeting was held to discuss the food needs of some immigrants and others in our parish. We need to decide the kinds of food items to be gathered and the best method for distributing them. The group will re-convene to plan next steps. This is collaboration involves SJC, Pastoral Care Council, Latino Ministries and parish administration.</li><li>We raised \$2,200 for Operation Neighbor, an organization that provides fire-fighting equipment and medical supplies for Ukraine.</li><li>We're making plans for an "Immigration 101" event at St. Odilia tentatively to be held on a weekend in late January 2026.</li><li>SJC is sponsoring a new Just Faith course, "Faith and Immigration Justice," which will be held weekly at St. Odilia January 8 through February 26, 2026. See the bulletin or the SJC webpage for registration details.</li><li>We have the initial designs for a St. Odilia "Themes of Catholic Social Teaching" bookmark which we hope to have ready for distribution in January 2026.</li></ul>
