### Principal updates

- Staffing Hired new front office employee, and hired new chef.
- **Student Services** in person services have started. At middle school level it has been seamless. Elementary has been more challenging to schedule for. Computers have been delivered for speech services. Busing has been working ok.

- MAP testing completed on 10/4, results and letters will go out to families on 10/25. Large time commitment through the grades. Winter testing in 3,4,5 to keep an eye on those scores. Seeing testing fatigue, if have 4 tests in the older grades.
- Free/Reduced Lunch Program update Breakfast has been more consistent in numbers. Hired a new chef last week. Audit went well and only had small items to review.
- Staffing update: hired new front office administrative assistant and starting next week.
- Marathon update today was last in person contributions. Online pledging still going on. Great turnout for the marathon.
- **PLC report and PLC goals** Focused on campaign [January to July 2025] from the Archdiocese, how would the parish spend these funds that could be received. What is the communication plan for fund raising efforts? \$3,000,000 goal for the church (60% to St. O's and 40% to Archdiocese), if we go over the goal amount, it could bring 80% to St. O's.
- Middle School/High School sports discussion If student that does not live within the boundry of MVHS, could they still play? Yes; Transfer rule impact? No, it does not start until 9th grade. If can only partner with 1 school, cannot promise that kids will get a spot on the HS teams. MVHS [AD] prefers that kids that do not plan on going to MVHS to not go out for their teams.
- Volunteer strategy What are the volunteer needs? Who is showing up, who is signing up? Other schools do they have a required commitment? What is it? Should we have a grade to promote throughout the school year? (ex. 2nd grade is November)
- **Future parent speakers -** anxiety, growth mindset, grit & resilience, sensory, technology, and social media are some potential topics for speakers.
- Potential switch of meeting date in Dec, Jan December 17th or January 7th in place of Dec and Jan.
