

## Paid Catholic Family & Medical Leave

### BASELINE – MEDICAL LEAVE

- The medical leave portion of the employer **Baseline** contribution (0.342%).
- The default is to be imputed income to the employee in BAS & Paylocity.
  - The employee will pay taxes on 0.342% of all eligible **earnings** each pay period.
  - The employee will also see a **deduction** of this amount, since the medical portion of the employer Baseline contribution is considered imputed income and not actual wages paid to the employee.
  - The employee will see both the earnings and the deduction amounts on their pay stub (see example on page 3, below).
  - When the employee files for a claim, the employer portion (40% of earnings) will be tax-free (federal/state income tax, FICA/MHI).
- If the employee opts out of treating this amount as imputed income in BAS, updated codes will automatically be sent to Paylocity.
  - The baseline medical portion will not be taxable to the employee.
  - The employee will not see this portion on their pay stub.
  - When employee files for a claim, the employer portion (40% of earnings) will be taxed (federal/state income tax, FICA/MHI).
  - Earnings code is set up in Paylocity to calculate amount due by employer and paid through Agency Check. This is viewable on the administrator side in Paylocity on the employee record under Pay then Checks or using the Agency Check Summary Report (see instructions below).
- The employer funds for the Baseline contributions will be sent to the Pastoral Center through an Agency Check in Paylocity (see below for instructions on running a report).

### BASELINE – FAMILY LEAVE

- The family leave portion of the employer **Baseline** contribution (0.228%) is not considered income at the time the employer remits these contributions.
- The employee will not see this portion on their pay stub.
- When employee files for a claim, the employer portion (40% of earnings) will be taxed (federal/state income tax, FICA/MHI).
- Earnings code is set up in Paylocity to calculate amount due by employer and paid through Agency Check. This is viewable on the administrator side in Paylocity on the employee record under Pay then Checks or using the Agency Check Summary Report (see instructions below).
- The employer funds for the Baseline contributions will be sent to the Pastoral Center through an Agency Check in Paylocity (see below for instructions on running a report).

### FULL BENEFIT

- Employees can opt into the **Full CFML** benefit, which provides an additional 40% of earnings when a claim is approved.
- The employee will see a deduction of 0.57% on all eligible earnings (see example on page 3, below).
- This deduction is an after-tax deduction.
- When an employee files for a claim for the employee's own medical condition, the employee portion will be tax-free (federal/state income tax, FICA/MHI).
- Employee contributions will be sent to the Pastoral Center through an Agency Check in Paylocity (see below for instructions on running a report).

## PAYLOCITY EARNINGS & DEDUCTION CODES

Code	Type	Purpose	Taxed?	Description
CFMLF	earnings code	employer/Baseline contribution for family leave	no	for all CFML-eligible employees, since this portion cannot be added to imputed income, per IRS guidance
CFMLR	earnings code	employer/Baseline contribution for medical leave	no	for employees who opt out of imputing the medical portion of the employer contribution to themselves
CFMLT	earnings code	employer/Baseline contribution for medical leave	yes	for employees who have the medical portion of the employer contribution imputed to themselves (this is the “in”)
CFMLT	deduction code	employer/Baseline contribution for medical leave	n/a	for employees who have the medical portion of the employer contribution imputed to themselves (this is the “out”)
CFMLE	deduction code	employee voluntary deduction/Full contribution	yes	for employees electing the Full benefit

## PAYLOCITY AGENCY CHECK SUMMARY REPORT

The CFML codes are considered agency codes in Paylocity. Paylocity will remit all CFML funds to the CFML program on each processed check run. These will be listed on the Agency Check Summary Report within Paylocity. Totals for the employer and employee portions will be on separate pages.
