MAKE EYE EXAMS PART OF YOUR ROUTINE

Unlike vision screenings, routine eye exams are performed by specially trained eye care professionals, such as an optometrist or ophthalmologist. During an exam, they'll perform a series of tests that evaluate your vision and eye health, and check for disease. Schedule an appointment today.

YOUR EYES CAN TELL YOU A LOT ABOUT YOUR HEALTH

Routine eye exams can help detect chronic health conditions, such as diabetes.

Common types of eye disease

Glaucoma

The second-leading cause of blindness worldwide.¹ Glaucoma is a group of eye conditions that damage the optic nerve. Early detection and treatment can often stop damage to your vision.

Cataracts

A cataract is the clouding of your eye's lens. The condition often develops without notice, and worsens as you age. Diabetics are up to five times more likely to develop cataracts.³

Diabetic Retinopathy

The leading cause of blindness among adults.² It develops when the blood vessels in your retina become damaged. The condition often goes undiagnosed, but is treatable if detected early.



WHEN TO SCHEDULE AN EYE EXAM

The right time to schedule an eye exam depends on the individual and is often based on age and overall health. You should schedule routine eye exams based on your doctor's recommendation or if you experience any of the following symptoms:

- **Floater, flashing lights, or dark spots in your field of vision**
- **Blurry or double vision**
- **Pain or pressure in one or both eyes**
- **Difficulty focusing**
- **Decreased peripheral vision**
- **Partial or total vision loss**
