- Observe the days of fasting (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday) and abstinence (Ash Wednesdays and Fridays in Lent) established by the Church.
- 5. Help to provide for the needs of the Church.

REDELEGATION OF EHMC

Information from Archdiocese office of Worship and Archbishop: The delegation for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, with the exception of those who completed the Basic Workshop after January 1, 2023, will expire at the end of November 2023. In order to be delegated for a new five-year term, each EMHC must participate in either a re-delegation session in their parish or have participated in the live re-delegation session which was held in April. Please note that new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must attend one of the basic formation workshops. Attendance at a re-delegation session does not fulfill the formation requirement for new EMHC. Attendance at a workshop for EMHCs is required before a person can be delegated by the archbishop to serve in this ministry. All Saints Will host the workshop at our parish- Althea Holmes Hall on 11/18/2023 at 1Pm.

REFLECTION

November 5, 2023Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time Under one father

Have we not all the one father? Has not the one God created us?" asks Malachi at the end of the first reading (2:10). Indeed, we all have the same Father in heaven, as Jesus points out in the Gospel. We have all been created by God. This should give us some humility, for it means that none of us is created more in the image of God than anyone else. The person I see begging on a street corner or emaciated in a drought-stricken region of the world is created in the image of God, just like me. Therefore, all people deserve a basic dignity because they are created and loved by God. For the same reason, none of us should feel unworthy of that basic dignity because no one is created less in the image of God than anyone else.
