#### REDELEGATION OF EHMC

Information from Archdiocese office of Worship and Archbishop: The delegation for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, with the exception of those who completed the Basic Workshop after January 1, 2023, will expire at the end of November 2023. In order to be delegated for a new five-year term, each EMHC must participate in either a re-delegation session in their parish or have participated in the live re-delegation session which was held in April. Please note that new Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must attend one of the basic formation workshops. Attendance at a re-delegation session does not fulfill the formation requirement for new EMHC. Attendance at a workshop for EMHCs is required before a person can be delegated by the archbishop to serve in this ministry. All Saints Will host the workshop at our parish- Althea Holmes Hall on 11/18/2023 at 1Pm.

## November 12, 2023 Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings call us to keep vigil as we wait for the light, for the dawn, for the One who called himself the light of the world. What can help us as we wait in joyful anticipation?
