Each Catholic is called to full and active participation in the life of the Church

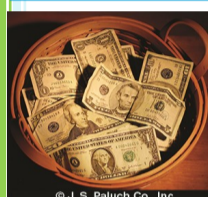
and has the right and responsibility to:

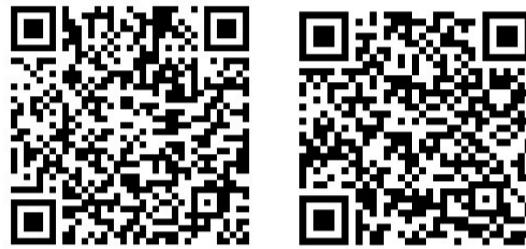
**December 3, 2023 First Sunday of Advent**
