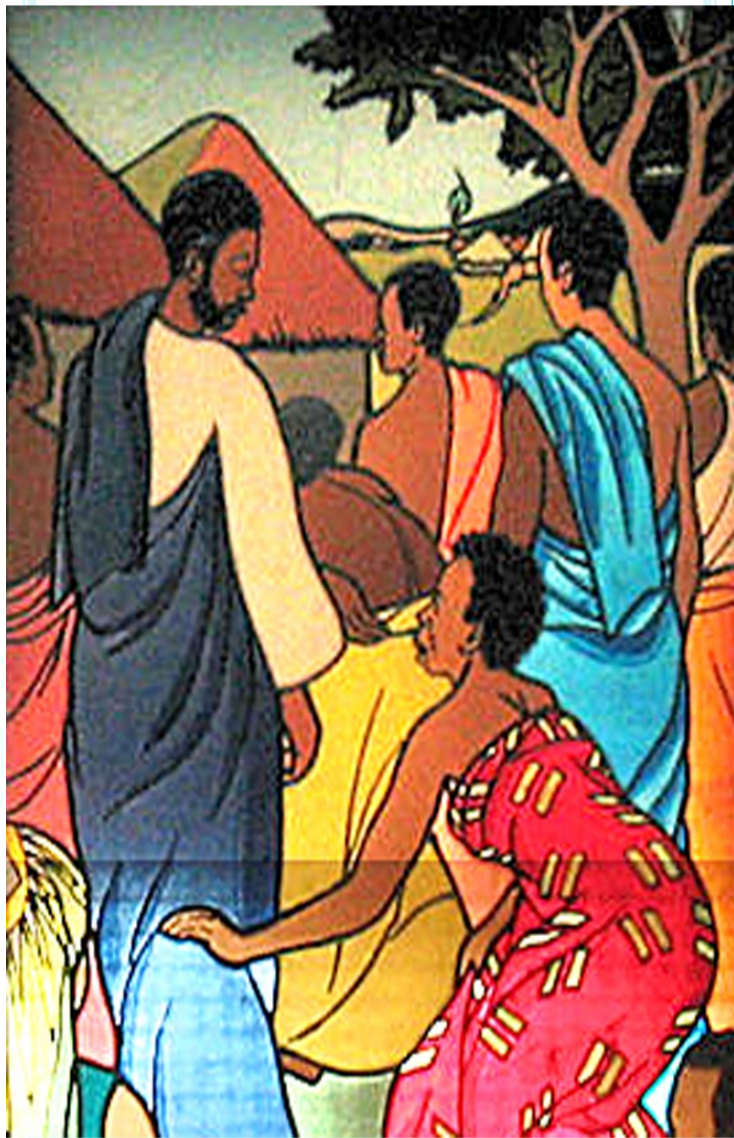

**REFLECTION**

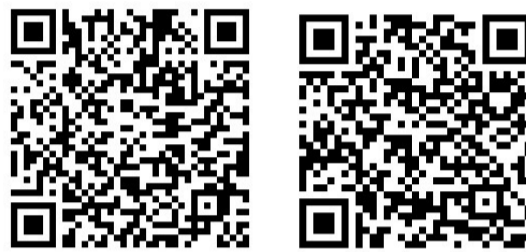
**February 4th , Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time**
