HOW TO MAKE A REPORT:

If you suspect abuse or neglect of a child, elder or vulnerable adult*, or if abuse has been disclosed to you:

1. Call CPS (800-252-5400); get a case number or copy of report.

AND/OR

Call the Police or 911; get a case number or copy of report.

AND

2. Immediately report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal and submit the Confidential Notice of Concern with CPS report information.

In the case of alleged abuse by clergy or Church personnel, contact the Victim Assistance Hotline, Director of Safe Environment, or Chancellor of the Diocese directly.

*A vulnerable adult can include someone who habitually lacks the use of reason.

DID YOU KNOW?

In order to serve as a Godparent or Sponsor for Confirmation, you must be in full communion with the Catholic Church. Specific requirements from Canon Law 874: At least 16 years old, unless the local bishop specifies a different age, or the minister of baptism believes a specific case warrants an exception. Must be a practicing Catholic, regularly attending Mass, receiving sacraments, and a registered member of a parish. Must be baptized, confirmed, and have received First Communion. IF married, must be married in the Church, and if divorced must not be remarried outside of the Church. Must not be bound by any canonical penalty. Cannot be the parents or legal guardians of the person being baptized. At least one godparent must be Catholic. A baptized, non-Catholic Christian can participate as a witness, but only alongside a Catholic godparent. (If the person was baptized Catholic, they cannot serve as a Christian Witness)

Responsibilities of a Godparent:

To assist the parents in the child's religious education and spiritual formation. To be a positive role model and example of a Christian life. To support the child's parents in their role as the primary religious educators. To pray for the child and participate in the child's sacramental life.

Important Considerations:

Godparents are not legal guardians. The Church encourages the choice of godparents who can truly support the child's faith journey. While intellectual knowledge of Catholic teaching is important, it is not a substitute for a lived faith.

QUO VADIS 2025

Quo Vadis is a FREE one-day vocation discernment retreat for young men in High School who are living in the Diocese of Fort Worth. The camp is a rare chance for High School young men to begin considering their vocation from God by speaking with priests and seminarians. Held at Montserrat Jesuit Retreat House, 600 N Shady Shores Dr., Lake Dallas, TX 75065 on **Friday, July 25, 2025**. Boys who graduate 8th grade in May/June 2025 and will be freshmen in school year 2025-2026 are eligible to register. Young men who graduate high school in May/June 2025 are eligible to register. If a young man is 18 years old he will be required to complete the Safe Environment Program of the Diocese of Fort Worth, prior to attending. 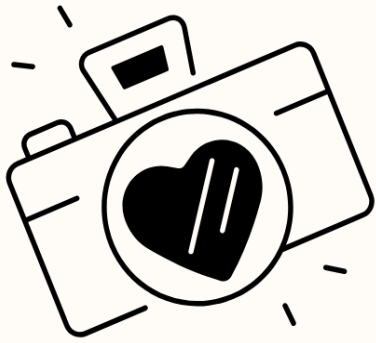
