HOW TO MAKE A REPORT:

1. Call CPS (800-252-5400); get a case number or copy of report.

AND /OR

Call the Police or 911; get a case number or copy of report.

AND

 Immediately report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal <u>and</u> submit the Confidential Notice of Concern with CPS report information.

DID YOU KNOW?

For Catholics, having their marriage recognized by the Church is important because the Catholic Church views marriage as a sacrament, a sacred union between a man and a woman, and a reflection of Christ's love for the Church. A Catholic marriage, recognized by the Church, is seen as a path to holiness and a way to receive God's grace to strengthen the marital bond. It also signifies a commitment to the Church's teachings on marriage and family life. "The matrimonial covenant, by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership of the whole of life, is by its nature ordered toward the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of offspring; this covenant between baptized persons has been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament." CCC 1601

Here's why it's important:

Sacrament: Catholics believe marriage is a sacrament, a visible sign of God's grace, and a sacred covenant with God. Fullness of the Sacraments: Recognizing the marriage in the Church allows Catholics to fully participate in the sacraments, including the Eucharist and Reconciliation, which are central to Catholic life. Grace and Blessings: A sacramental marriage is believed to bring God's grace, which strengthens the couple's commitment and helps them navigate the challenges of married life. Indissolubility: The Catholic Church teaches that marriage is a lifelong, indissoluble union. Recognizing the marriage in the Church reinforces this commitment. Family Life: Marriage is seen as the foundation of a loving and healthy family life and recognizing it within the Church aligns with Catholic teachings on family values. For Catholics who married outside the Church there is a process that allows them to bring their marriage into the Church and have it recognized as a sacrament. 

CONNECTING GIRLS TO CHRIST

BLAZE is a Walking with Purpose ministry for teen/tween girls that counteracts the way our society drives girls to question their identity, worth and beauty. Through BLAZE, we emphasize how a girl's identity is rooted in Christ as God's chosen, beloved daughter.

An antidote to bullying, feeling anxious, and body-image issues, BLAZE replaces lies with truth and strengthens girls from the inside out through the use of Scripture-based programs.

- 20 fun weekly lessons that girls will truly enjoy.
- Each week, participants are led through an ice breaker activity and a short lesson based on a lie found in the world and a truth found in Scripture.
- The girls leave with a small takeaway gift which corresponds with the lesson.

As the girls are introduced to the Bible in relevant and fresh ways, they will hear Jesus telling them how loved and beautiful they are!




