

2. Immediately report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal and submit the Confidential Notice of Concern with CPS report information.

Subject: 2025 - Annual Report of the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul

This past year the parishioners of Holy Family have continued their generous support of St. Vincent de Paul Conference with contributions of time, talent, and treasure. Currently, we have 30 active/full members and 8 associate members. All our members are volunteers who donate their time in service to our neighbors.

Holiday Food Program

The St. Vincent de Paul program that is perhaps most visible to parishioners is the food basket delivery program which occurs at Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas. This year, members of Holy Family parish donated the funds to purchase perishable food and provide grocery gift cards to neighbors in need. In addition to financial support, more than 160 parishioners came together with their families and friends to help us sort food and deliver baskets to these neighbors.

Angel Giving Tree Program

Members of Holy Family parish, including a precious class of first grade students of Holy Family school, participated in our Angel Giving Tree this Christmas. Thanks to your generosity, 87 children in need received gifts of clothing and toys!

Home Visits

These visits are the heart and soul of our ministry – that which distinguishes us from other organizations that serve the poor. Throughout the year, St. Vincent de Paul members go in pairs, making home visits in zip code areas near Holy Family Church. This year, we visited with 320 of the families who called our Helpline; we were able to pray with them, assess their needs, and provide some relief. Many of the callers who did not receive a home visit were given referrals to local agencies that might be able to help them with their specific needs. In some cases, we were able to partner with Catholic Charities for utility assistance.




