HOW TO MAKE A REPORT:

Call the Police or 911; get a case number or copy of report.

AND

2. Immediately report the alleged abuse to your supervisor, Priest or Principal and submit the Confidential Notice of Concern with CPS report information.

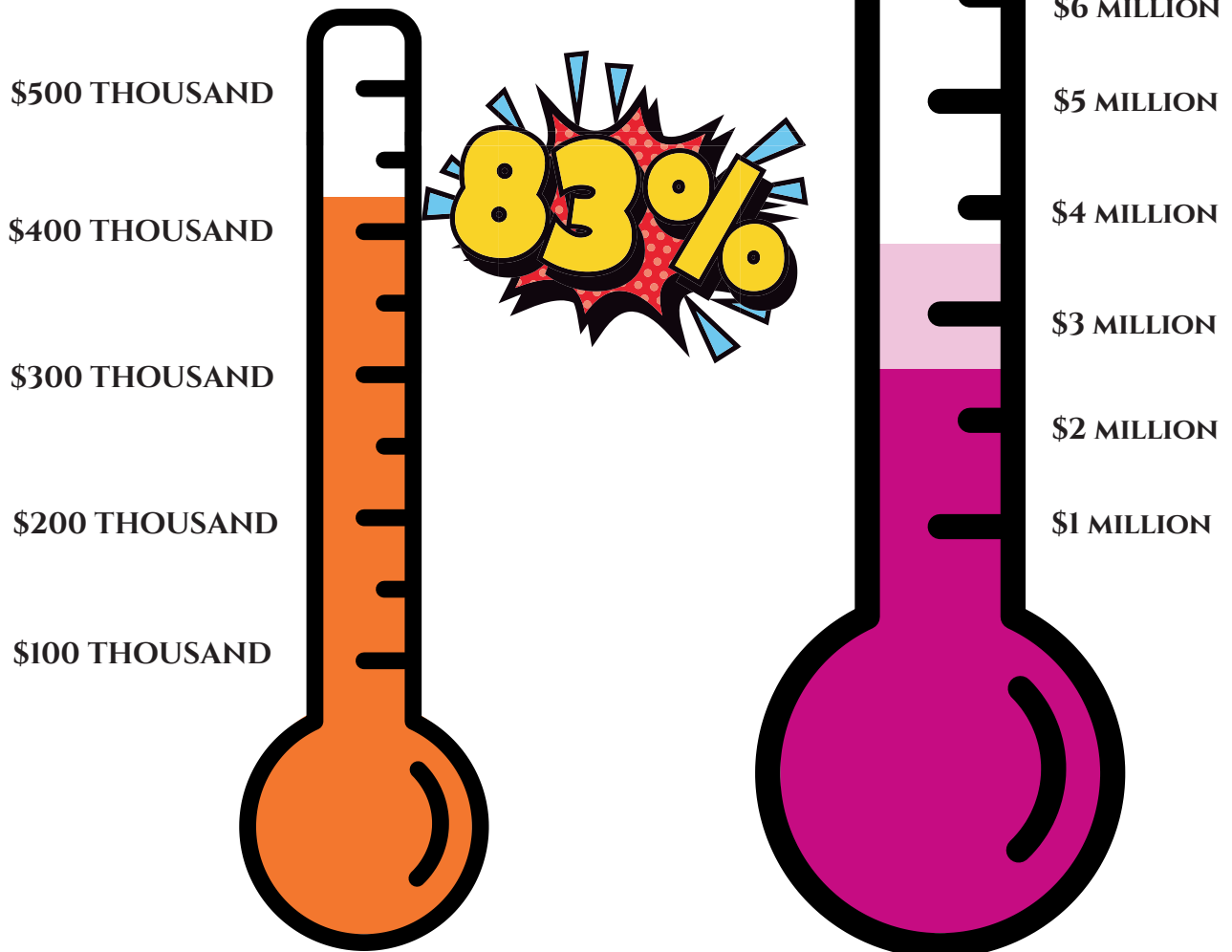

Novena for the Capital Campaign

Holy Family Parishioners, we ask you to join us in praying this Novena in support of the Capital Campaign, Our Faith, Our Family, Our Foundation. Please begin praying with Day 1 on Sunday, May 3 and conclude on Monday May 11.

St. Joseph, as the guardian of the Holy Family, we ask for your protection & guidance over our capital campaign. We ask for your intercession with God to provide for the needs of Holy Family parish.

- **Day 1 - Sunday May 3 (Model of Builders):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. St. Joseph, you are the faithful protector and intercessor for all who love and venerate you. We begin our novena today asking for your guidance over our capital campaign and for the architects and contractors. Watch over them St. Joseph and keep them safe, focusing on safety, skill, and dedication to God's glory. We ask for your intercession for precision in design and integrity in construction. *Close with an Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.*
- **Day 2 - Monday, May 4 (Provider):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. We begin our novena today seeking your divine guidance for our capital campaign, inspiring generous hearts, unity in purpose, and abundant blessings upon our fundraising efforts. With gratitude for the mission entrusted to our parish family, we pray not only for financial gifts but for all forms of support—prayer, volunteering, and advocacy—so that every member of our community feels called to participate. Help us to be like Mary, saying "yes" to Your call, and like St. Joseph, who labored tirelessly to provide for the Holy Family. Remind us that we are stewards of Your abundance, using all our gifts to build Your kingdom here on earth. Bless and prosper our donors, volunteers, and supporters in their families and businesses, so they may always have an abundance for every good work. May their sacrifices, united in faith and spirit, build us into "Living Stones" for Your spiritual house, ensuring future generations will find a haven of peace and prayer within these walls. *Close with an Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.*
- **Day 3 - Tuesday, May 5 (Protector):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. O St. Joseph, whose protection is so great, so strong, so prompt before the throne of God, I place in you all the interests and desires of our parish family. Assist us by your powerful intercession as we seek to raise funds for this capital campaign. Obtain for us the spiritual and temporal blessings we need to complete this holy task for God's greater glory. *Close with an Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.*
- **Day 4 – Wednesday, May 6 (Pillar of Families):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. St. Joseph, you were entrusted with the care and education of the Child Jesus. We come to you today as we are preparing to raise enough funds to build a new addition for our youngest disciples, a place where wisdom and virtue will flourish, and will offer a safe, nurturing environment for our children. We ask for your protection for their parents that they may find this school a true partner in their children's education. We ask for your protection over our students, for those who attend our parish school presently and those who will learn inside the walls of our new addition, that they may grow in "wisdom, age and grace." *Close with an Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.*
- **Day 5 – Thursday, May 7 (Obedient Servant):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. O Blessed St. Joseph, we ask you to guide those who have answered the call to lead and

serve. Grant them the foresight and wisdom you possessed when you led Mary and Jesus. May they be clear in their vision, prudent in their planning, and courageous in the face of challenges. Fill them with the Holy Spirit so that their leadership is always marked by humility and grace. Strengthen our volunteers who give so generously of their time and talent. - **Day 7 – Saturday May 9 (Wise and Prudent):** In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. O Blessed St. Joseph, you were the faithful and prudent steward of the King of Kings. You managed humble resources of the Holy Family with great care and foresight. We turn to you today as we manage the finances of this capital campaign. Help us to distinguish what is necessary and what is secondary. Grant us the clarity to make decisions that are fiscally responsible yet bold in faith, ensuring every dollar given is used to build up God’s Kingdom. *Close with an Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be.
