

I know I will never be able to replace Zeon who was the parish dog at Annunciation Byzantine Catholic Church in Homer Glen, but I would love to invite you again to this very special event. After getting to see how much all the children enjoyed attending Christmas on the Prairie, I now know why Zeon loved this event and why The Feast of St. Nicholas was one of his most favorite feast days!



This is an important feast day in the Byzantine Church and one that is celebrated by children all around the world. Many of you may know the tradition of leaving a shoe outside the door and during the night St. Nicholas stops by to fill the shoe with goodies if you were good or coal if you were bad.
