Monday, April 3


"Mary took a liter of costly perfumed oil...anointed the feet of Jesus and dried them with her hair."

Nard oil, used by Mary to anoint Jesus' feet, comes from the spikenard plant.






Color in the herbs and jars to show what the liter of perfume looked like.

Unleavened Bread Recipe

- 2 cups + 2 tablespoons of flour
- 1 cup of cold water
- 1/2 teaspoon of salt

1. Combine salt and flour together in a bowl. Stir in the water until the dough comes together in a ball. Knead for 5 minutes.
2. Ask your parents for help using the stove! Pre-heat the skillet over medium-low heat.
3. Pinch off 5-7 pieces of dough and form into small balls. Roll out each piece on a lightly floured surface, about 6 inches each.
4. Cook on a hot skillet for 2 minutes on each side.









Holy Thursday, April 6

John 13:1-20




Choose a person's feet to wash. Write their name on the paper foot, as well as why you are grateful for them. Gather some supplies and wash their feet, just like Jesus taught us!





"What is happening? Today there is a great silence over the earth, a great silence, and stillness, a great silence because the King sleeps..."
