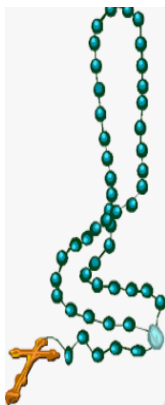

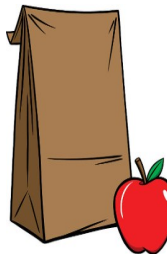

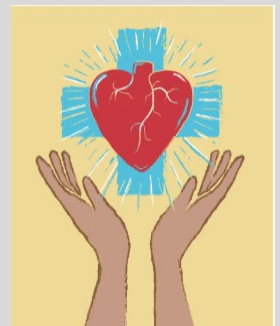
**Caregiver Grant Program:** Family Caregivers for individuals who meet certain criteria such as age, presence of dementia, or developmental or developmental or other disabilities may apply for a grant of up to \$2,500 from the Maryland Department of Aging to cover certain caregiving expenses. These include alterations to a home for easier access, equipment to care for the person at home, adult day care or a home health aide, assistive technology and more. To be eligible, the caregiver must have a federal adjusted gross income of \$75,000 or less if a single-filer and \$150,000 if filing jointly. Check with the Department of Aging for guidelines.

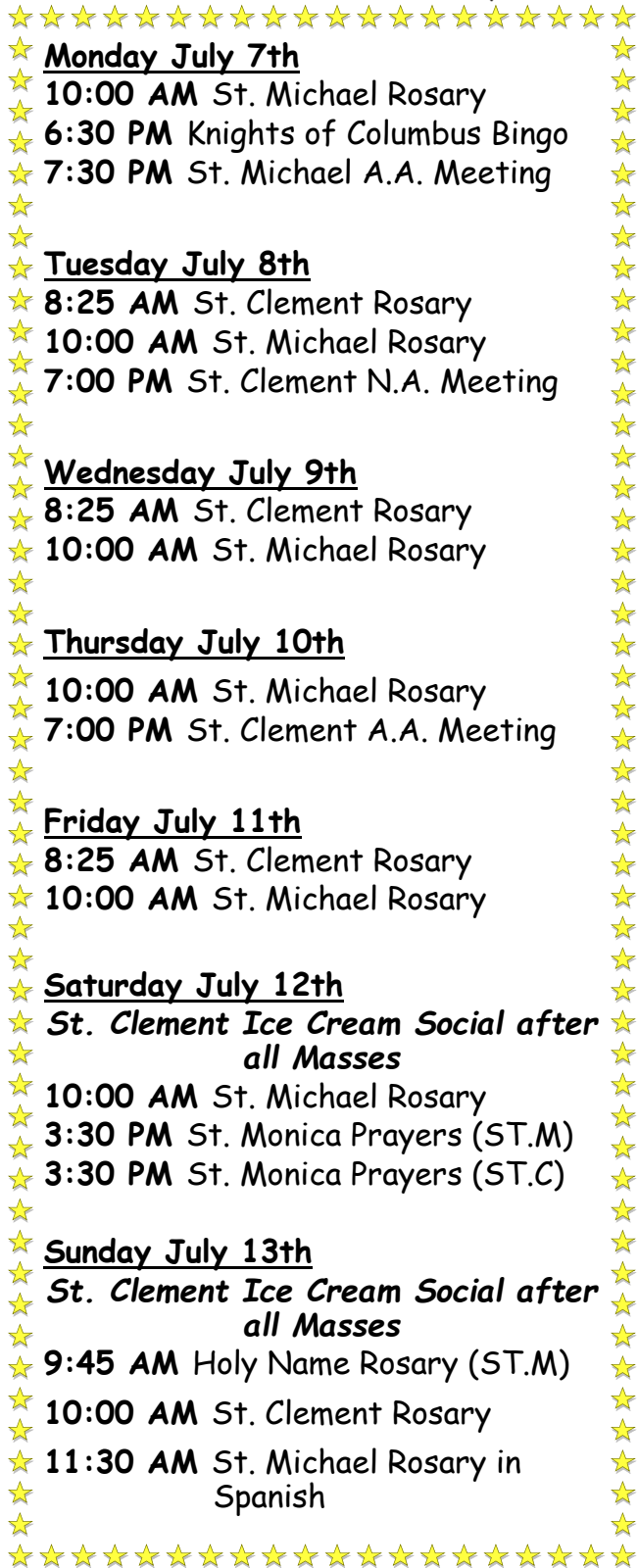
## **Respect Life**

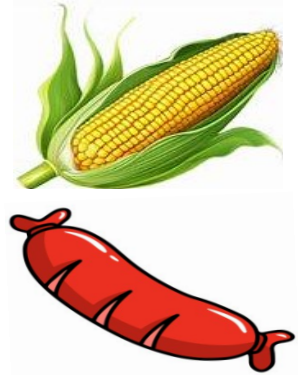
