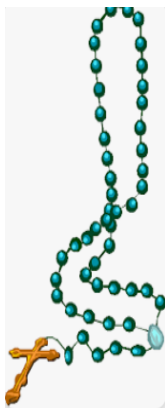


Rosary Recitals

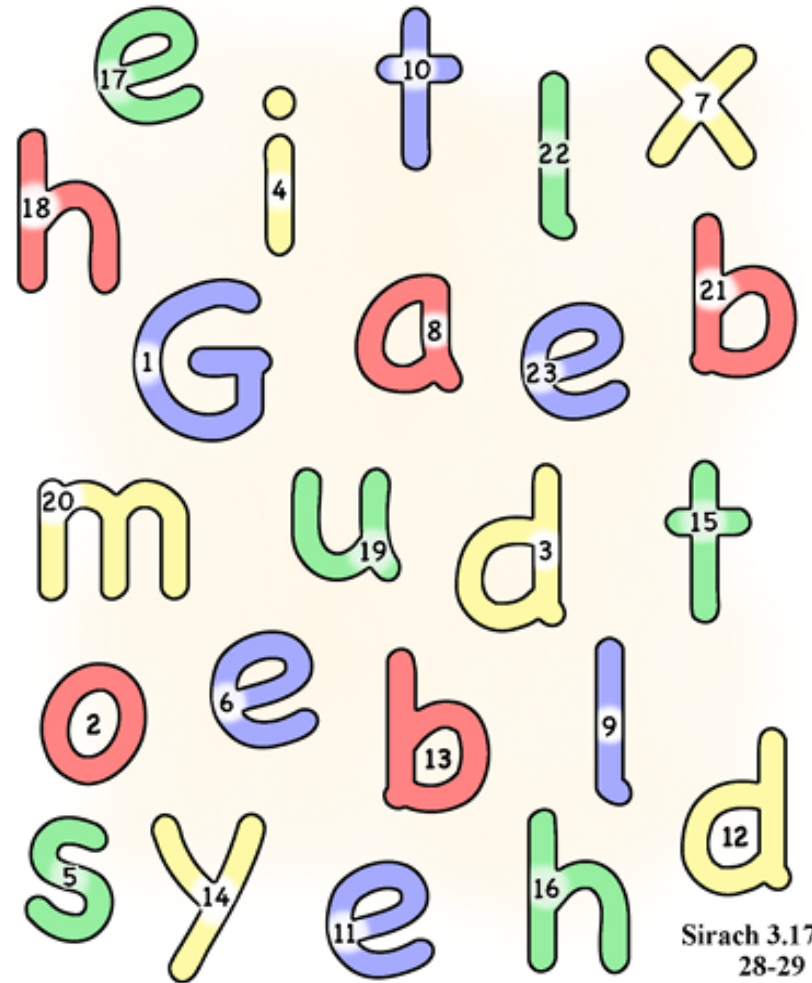
