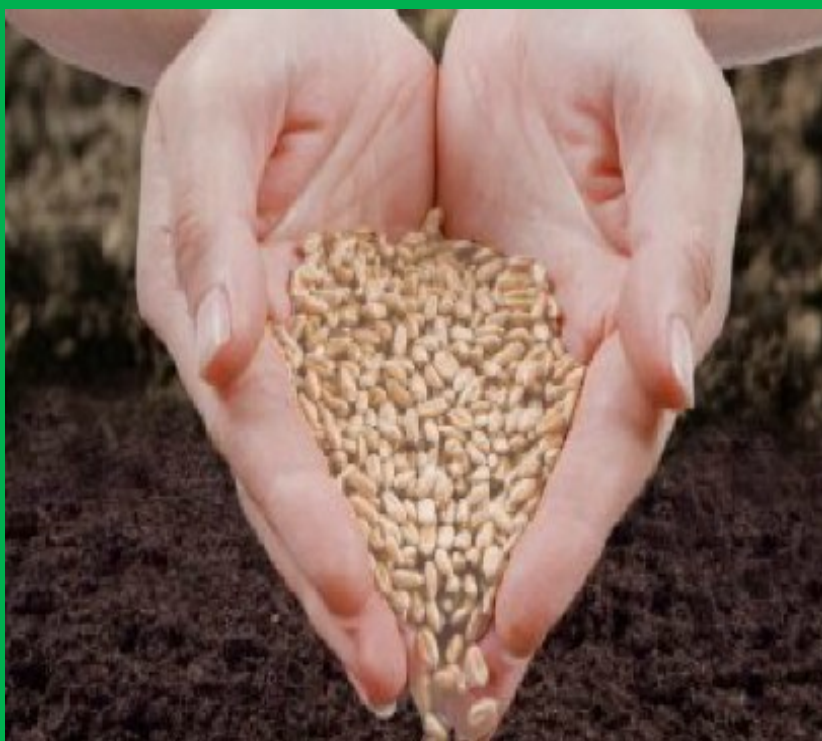

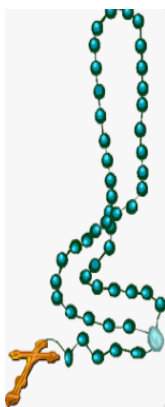


## **Rosary Recitals**

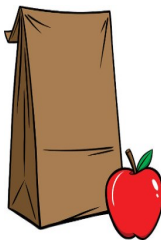

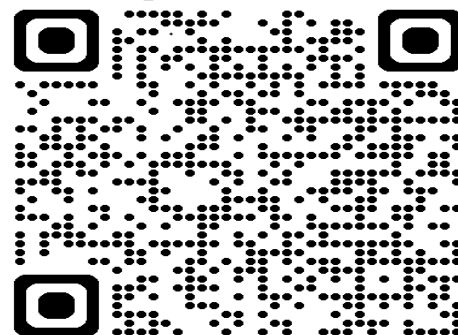

## **We Are Many Parts International Festival**

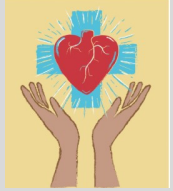
