




LET'S CELEBRATE! LET'S CELEBRATE!






You might be wondering why we have a birthday for a building, though! Well, a church is not just an ordinary building. It is made specially for the worship of God in the Mass. A church is also a symbol

St. Clement Mary Hogbauer Finance Fiscal Year Report 2025

As seen in previous years, we present to our parishioners the Finance Fiscal Year Report 2025 with the purpose of keeping our community up to date on the management of Parish Resources.

In the FY 2025, the earned revenue totaled was of \$413,050 representing a 4.94% increment in comparison to the FY 2024. It is important to note that the Offertory Collections concept diminished 0.42% affecting the electronic donations, reflecting a decrease of 7.83%. Second Collections decreased 0.10% and holy days decreased 14.63%. Two concepts that reflect an increase due to activities organized to commemorate the 100th anniversary are donations for a specific purpose, which increased by 48% in other operating income, and benefits income (fundraising) by 62.58% in specific operating areas.

Expenses reflect a total of \$464,460, representing an increment of 16.57% in comparison to FY 2024. In particular, the highest changes are reflected in Administration Expenses by 28.97% and Worship Expenses by 38.71%. The Administration Expense concept that increased most is IT Expenses by 49%. Just as fundraisers for the 100th anniversary became higher, Hospitality expenses also increased significantly in comparison to FY2024. Offertory Envelope expenses increased \$947 in comparison to FY 2024, but it must be considered that this increment corresponds to a rise in offering collection (envelopes) by 1.85%. Worship Expense increments are due to the subcontracting of extra clergy and shared expenses for the pastorate associate. Payment for accumulated benefits and shared expenses generated an increment of 13% in Labor costs and 64% in Employee Benefits in comparison to the year previous due to administrative adjustments in staff.

Expenses surpassed the earned revenue totaled, as a result giving a deficit of \$51,410. Other extraordinary revenue totaled \$111,267. As there were also registered extraordinary expenses totaling \$14,460, for roofing repairs in church and food pantry, broken window repairs, church carpet installation. Thanks to extraordinary donations, at the end of the FY, we can report a net income of \$45,397.

Please keep in mind that earned operation revenue should be greater than operation expenses to continue keeping our parish ministries operations. We encourage parishioners to pray for our parish and sharing their blessings to continue strengthening our church.
