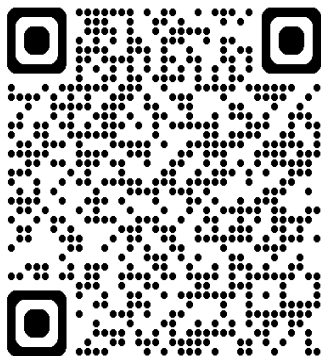

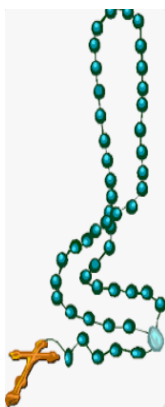


## Rosary Recitals

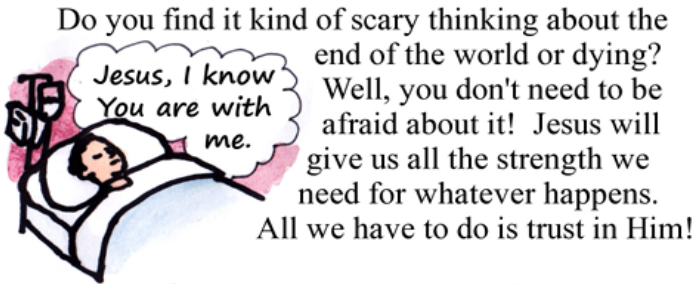


# God is With Us to the End

# St. Michael the Archangel Parish

## Finance Report FY 2025

With the purpose of keeping our community up to date on the use of parish resources, we present the Finance Report for the Fiscal Year 2025.

During the FY 2025, the total earned revenue was of \$544,508, representing, a general 29% increase in comparison to the FY 2024. Increments are mainly due to the offertory collection, with an increase of 11%. It is important to note that offertory envelope donations increased by 21.33% but electronic donations were reduced by 19.31%. Loose collections also increased by 15.65%. Donations for Evangelization & Catechesis programs reduced by 24%. Other concepts affected were 'other donations', diminishing by 27%. Donations for specific areas such as poor box, and Archdiocese Collections incremented by a total of 58%. As a result, at the end of fiscal year 2025, gross profit was 29% higher compared to fiscal year 2024.

Expenses ascended to \$590,096 for the FY 2025. Significant increases were recorded compared to fiscal year 2024, represented by a 56% increase in Evangelization and a 27% increase in facility maintenance costs. One of the factors that increased the cost of the facilities was the outsourcing of maintenance services for plumbing, air conditioning and heating repairs, which represented an increase of 19% in comparison with the previous year; Technology Expenses increased by 60% due to IT maintenance. Worship Expenses increased by 23%, this is due to additional hiring of music and clergy services. There was also 2 valuable hirings, which include youth ministry coordinator and communications coordinator. This represents the increment seen in employee benefits and labor costs.

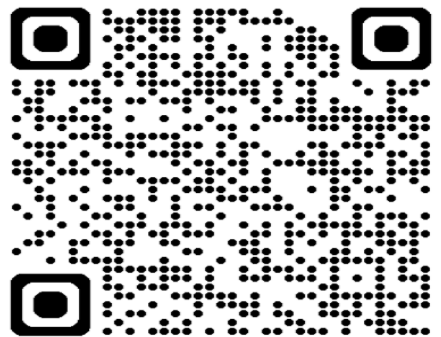
Expenses were greater than the earned revenue totaled, resulting in a deficit of \$45,588 for the FY 2025.

Other earned revenue was generated from the window campaign and other restricted donations, represented from a total of \$56,964, interests, dividends and investments totaled \$16,539 and a Will donation totaled \$96,098. Ascending the result for 'Other income' to \$169,542, representing 27% less in comparison to the previous FY; The reduction is justified because the donations pledged for the window campaign are about to be complete. We also have other extraordinary expenses that represented \$284,401, an additional 89% in comparison to the previous Fiscal Year. Majority of this expense was used towards invoices from the window repair project.

The result at the end of the FY 2025 reflects a deficit of \$160,447.

To continue keeping our parish ministries operations, it is necessary that earnings are greater than operation costs. We encourage parishioners to pray for our parish and sharing their blessings to continue strengthening our church.
