### Baptisms:

Parents and Godparents are required to attend Preparation Classes. Please call the Parish Office to arrange for both Preparation Class and Baptism.

### Marriage:

Couples planning to be married should contact a priest or deacon at least six months before the anticipated date. All engaged couples must take a Marriage Preparation Course as required by the Archdiocese. Do not set a date or reserve a hall until after you have met with a priest or deacon.

If you are interested in becoming Catholic or completing your initiation by receiving the sacraments of Eucharist and or/Confirmation, contact the Faith Formation office.

**Pastoral Care of the Sick:** If a parishioner is in the hospital or homebound and unable to attend Mass and wishes to receive Holy Communion, please contact the Parish Office. In case of emergency call the Parish Office anytime, day or night. Please notify the Parish office if a parishioner is in the hospital and wishes to be anointed. If Baltimore County closes early, then all events scheduled at the Pastorate are cancelled and pastorate offices will close early.

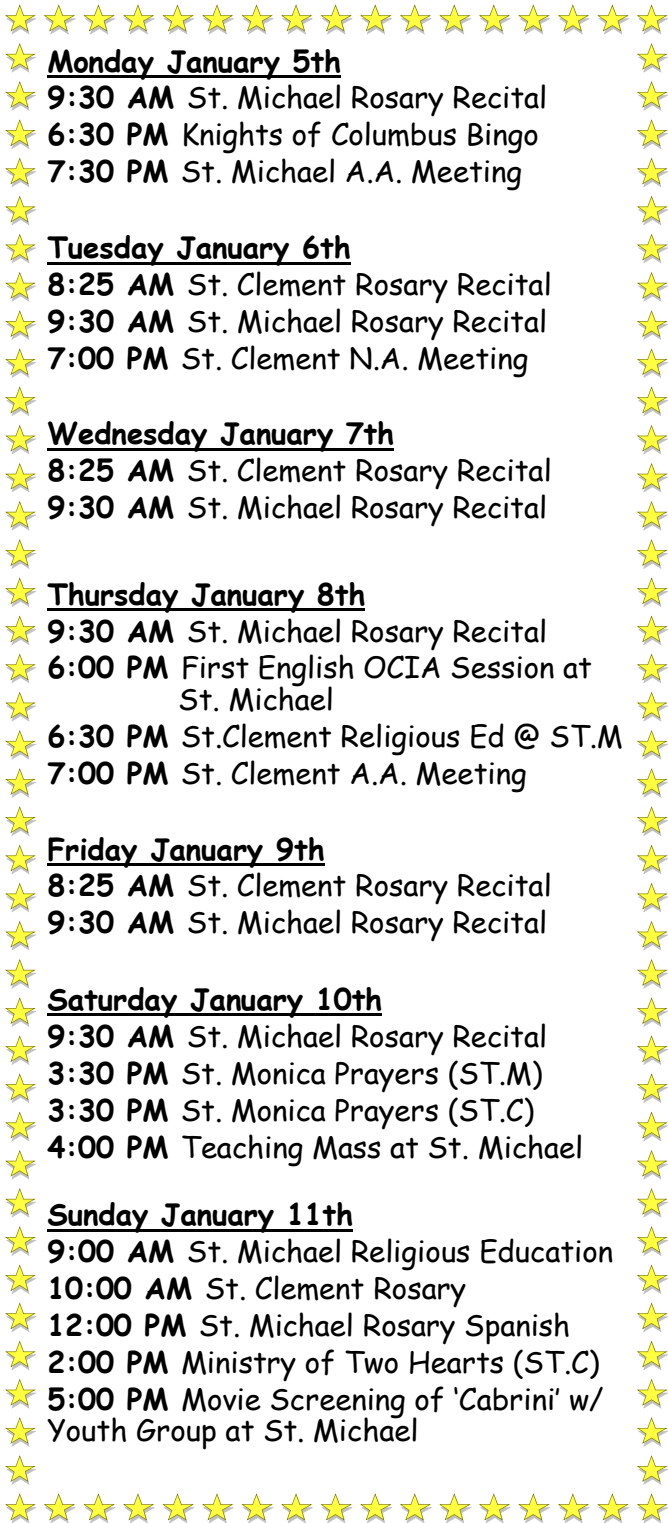

*This training is designed for all parish volunteers and staff who support the safe assembly of parish liturgies and events—including ushers, greeters, sacristans, clergy, and others entrusted with creating a secure worship environment. - \* Risk factors and triggers
- \* Environmental and personal stressors
- \* Warning behaviors that may influence an individual's decision to commit a harmful act
- \* Outlines the mitigating factors strategies that could help prevent acts of targeted violence

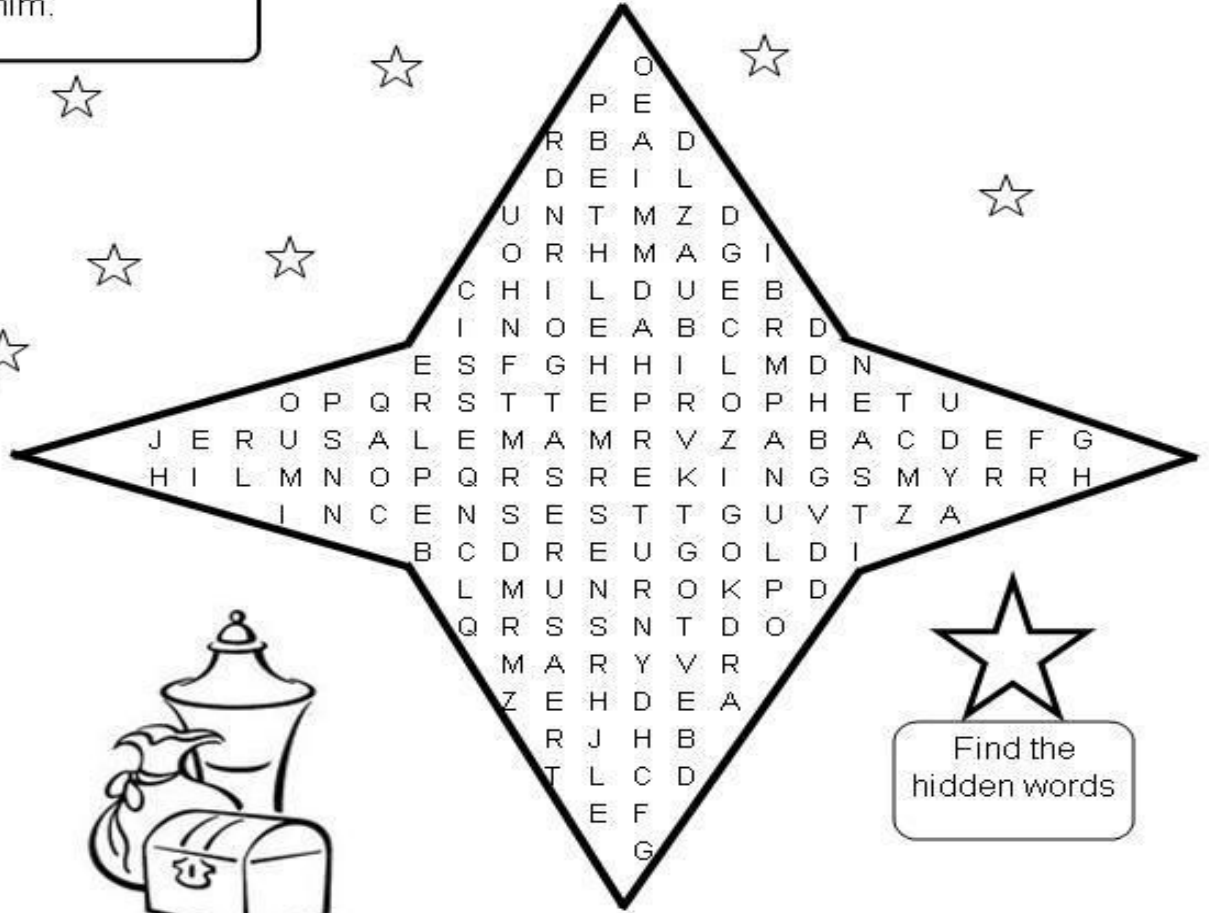

Kathryn Greenbeck** is a 23-year veteran of the Baltimore County Police Department, where she has held leadership positions as a patrol supervisor, training instructor, and assistant precinct commander. She currently leads the Behavioral Assessment Unit, overseeing key teams such as the Mobile Crisis Team, Crisis Negotiation Team, and Threat Management Team. With a Master of Science in Criminal Justice from the University of Baltimore, Lt. Greenbeck specializes in threat management, crisis intervention, and behavioral threat assessment. As a master trainer for the Department of Homeland Security's National Threat Evaluation and Reporting Office, she provides expert instruction on identifying and mitigating potential threats. Her work bridges the gap between law enforcement and behavioral health, ensuring proactive approaches to crisis intervention as well as school and workplace safety.



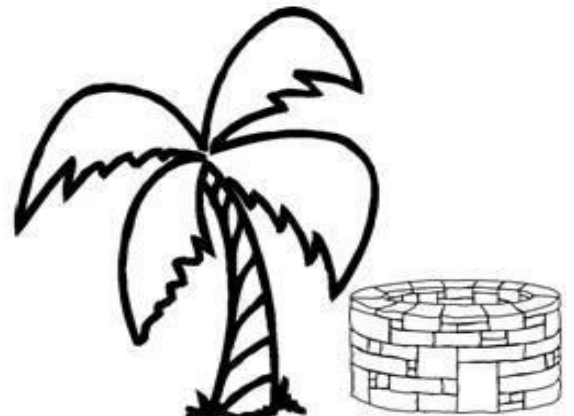
