





Check in begins at 8:30 AM, and the session will begin promptly at 9:00 AM. The training will be led by **Lieutenant Kathryn Greenbeck**, M.S. Behavioral Assessment Unit Commander, Baltimore County Police Department

This training is designed for all parish volunteers and staff who support the safe assembly of parish liturgies and events—including ushers, greeters, sacristans, clergy, and others entrusted with creating a secure worship environment. Registrants must be at least 18 years of age or be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

The session will focus on:

- * Risk factors and triggers
- * Environmental and personal stressors
- * Warning behaviors that may influence an individual's decision to commit a harmful act
- * Outlines the mitigating factors strategies that could help prevent acts of targeted violence



Lt. Kathryn Greenbeck is a 23-year veteran of the Baltimore County Police Department, where she has held leadership positions as a patrol supervisor, training instructor, and assistant precinct commander. She currently leads the Behavioral Assessment Unit, overseeing key teams such as the Mobile Crisis Team, Crisis Negotiation Team, and Threat Management Team. With a Master of Science in Criminal Justice from the University of Baltimore, Lt. Greenbeck specializes in threat management, crisis intervention, and behavioral threat assessment. As a master trainer for the Department of Homeland Security's National Threat Evaluation and Reporting Office, she provides expert instruction on identifying and mitigating potential threats. Her work bridges the gap between law enforcement and behavioral health, ensuring proactive approaches to crisis intervention as well as school and workplace safety.



Jesus' Baptism Cross-Word Puzzle




