Lent Easter




Fasting

Fasting is a practice in self-discipline with a penitential focus. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics should eat only one full meal and two smaller meals which, combined, would not equal a single normal meal. Those ages 18-59, in reasonable health, are required to fast.

Abstinence

Abstinence refers to "abstaining" from meat. Catholics must refrain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent. Those 14 and older must abstain from meat.






