# Alleluia!

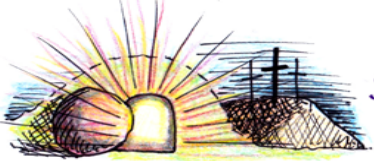

JESUS IS ALIVE!*

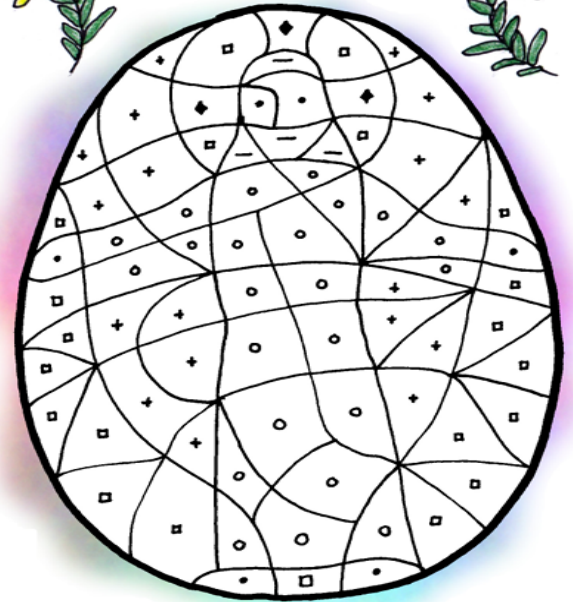
