CHECKING YOUR ACCOUNT BALANCE

I am working with JMC to get information on how parents can check lunch balances online or through their app. When we get more information, I will email it out to you.

PAYING MEAL BILLS ONLINE

We are in the process of setting up online lunch account payments. This will give parents the option to pay online with ACH or credit cards.

HOW TO FIND THE MENUS

You can find our menus posted on the main page of the school website. You can also email office@danburycatholic.org if you need a copy emailed or printed out and sent home.

SECONDS

We have had free seconds of fruits and veggies *as available* in the past. If we have extras, we will offer them to students at no cost. As we are working out cooking quantities for a crowd, if there are seconds available for students of the protein / main dish, students can purchase them at lunch for \$1. Extra milk is \$0.50. If you would like to restrict extras on your child's account, let Molly or Tabitha know.

FREE & REDUCED MEALS

If you'd like to apply for Free & Reduced Meals, you'll fill out the TADS application. On the main page of our website, in the blue section, click on the picture of a preschooler playing with a BeeBot robot. If you've already filled out TADS, reach out to Mrs. Petersen and let her know that you'd like her to look into your free/reduced status. TADS allows families to submit financial information to a secure, third party without having to share it with the school.

Grandparents Day Coming Up

Grandparents Day, an annual tradition at DC, is planned for Friday, October 3. More information will come about this after plans are finalized, but many grandparents or special guests that day may need the information sooner rather than later. Mass will likely be mid-morning with lunch and a program to follow. There is a 2-hour early out that day, so students can be dismissed with their guests once the program is over.
