



## JMC Family App

# Follow these steps to check or pay your lunch balance online.

- 1. Download the JMC Family App or go to https://danburycatholic.onlinejmc.com/Parent/Login.aspx
- 2. Our School PIN Code is 0402
- 3. Your Username is your last name with a capital first letter. (Mr. Smith's Username would be Smith)
- 4. If you haven't set up a password or if you forgot your password, click Password under the Verify button. It will email you a link to set your password.
- To check a lunch balance or deposit \$:
  In the top left corner, click the 3 lines and choose Meal Balance. It will show you the total balance. At the bottom of the screen will be a yellow button to make a deposit if you'd like.

Please note, there is a \$4 fee to pay online. This is to help cover our expense for this.





This summer, one of our amazing students, Taytum Schmidt, was diagnosed with Chiari with a Syrinx on her spine. Chiari is a condition in which brain tissue extends into the spinal canal and causes pressure in which can sometimes cause a Syrinx to form, which is a fluid-filled cyst on the spinal cord. She will need surgery to help her with this. Taytum has been so brave through all of this so far.

The students have been praying for Taytum at hallway prayer. We would like to support Taytum more here at school and, since September is Chiari Awareness Month, we are encouraging everyone to wear purple (the color for Chiari) on Tuesday, September 23. There should be no face paint or colored hair spray, but purple clothing would be great!

Students and staff will be learning more about this and we will continue to pray for Taytum and for her family.
